

# Medowie Netball Club Code of Behaviour

This Code of Behaviour aims to set out the minimum standards for anyone involved. It applies to all **players, parents, coaches, managers and spectators** when they play, train or take part in club sanctioned activities. The expected standards are as follows:

- Act within the rules and spirit of your sport.
- Promote fair play over winning at any cost.
- Encourage and support opportunities for people to learn appropriate behaviours and skills.
- Show respect and courtesy to all involved with the sport.
- Respect the decisions of officials, coaches and administrators.
- Display appropriate and responsible behaviour in all interactions.
- Act with integrity and objectivity, and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions.

## Players

- Give your best at all times.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit.
- Play by the rules and show respect for other players, coaches and officials.

## Coaches

- Place the safety and welfare of the athletes above all else.

## Parents

- Encourage your child to participate, do their best and have fun.
- Focus on your child's effort and performance, rather than winning or losing.

## Spectators

- Respect the effort and performances of players and officials.
