In 2018 we served 9,588 meals, had over 700 showers taken, and 7,028 volunteer hours. We helped a lot of people with the services we offer. We are geared up for another busy year. With the winter weather, we have given out lots of coats, hats, and gloves. The homeless also appreciate the coffee, sweet rolls and warm place in the mornings. We are always needing clothing to help those in need.



I try to have a hot lunch each day. I serve soup, ham & beans, meat loaf, chicken, etc. The items I need for a meal may surprise some of you, like ham & beans, I need 30 to 40 cans of beans or 2 or 3 packages of dry beans, 1-ham, 10 to 12 jiffy cornbread mixes, eggs, milk and dessert (4-cake mixes). The center can use food donations all the time.

We had over 50 new volunteers last year. Some are still helping but we are always looking for people or groups to help serve the lunchtime meal and help with different projects we do during the year. If you are interested in volunteering call me 913-233-2511.
