- New Hunt Field Program Ms Eryn Zeller is taking charge of and managing the Hunt Field. Here's a note from Eryn: "As we dive into what I consider the best riding season of the year, I'd like to take a moment to remind everyone of etiquette surrounding the jump field. Attached are the WRS jump guidelines; please review if you are a jumper, interested in learning to jump, or if you are curious in general about the safety guidelines.

Note to Boarders: if your horse grazes in the jump field, please do not leave them unattended while the jump field is in use.

I am excited to announce that I will be leading an initiative to clean up the upper ring behind Tex' house. Once the ring is cleaned up, it will be used as an occasional jumping ring on the weekends only. In the case that jumps are used on the weekends, jumps will be set up Fridays and will be removed no later than Sunday evening. If you arrange jumps in the upper ring, it is your responsibility to break down the jumps by Sunday evening. This pen is used as turnout over the week and must be clear of jumps to ensure the horses safety. The same rules regarding rain applies to this ring; please ensure ring is completely dry prior to use.
