Matthew 4:23 (NKJV) 23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.

Can you believe God for a miracle? A miracle is act of God. It is an event that appears to be contrary to the laws of nature. A miracle is an event or action that is amazing, extraordinary, or unexpected. Why is it we no longer believe God for the extra ordinary? Why don't people come to believers for healing or "right now breakthroughs"? I am confident that we need to teach more about the miracles of God. God is a God of impossibilities. Teaching about God's miraculous power creates an atmosphere for miracles. Can you expect "a miracle"?

Rom 10:1-3 (KJV) 1 Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved. 2 For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. 3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God.

It is important that, for miracles to occur, we know we need both teaching and preaching the gospel.
