Do You Remember Becoming a CHRISTIAN? Are You SURE?

he NEW BIRTH is a common experience that ALL believers share and NEVER FORGET. You may not remember the DAY or the YEAR, but you NEVER FORGET your SALVATION.

It's the moment when you **HEARD** the Word of God, and it <u>convinced</u> **YOU** that **YOU** were a **SINNER** and on the road to Hell. At that moment, you were made **SORROWFUL**, the **GODLY** sorrow "...that <u>WORKETH</u> [TO WORK FULLY; TO ACCOMPLISH] **REPENTANCE** to **SALVA-TION**" (2 Cor. 7:10).

This "<u>sorrow</u>" is known as **COMPUCTION**, that is, a <u>pricking of the conscience</u>, a sharp feeling of uneasiness brought on by a sense of guilt; remorse; regret. Have you ever felt that?

You then **ASKED** God in prayer like the publican, using similar words, "God be **MERCIFUL** to me a **SINNER**" (Luke 18:13). Afterward, as it was also with Paul the apostle, the scales of darkness, brought on by years of **UNBELIEF**, fell off, and **YOU**, like a <u>person born blind</u>, received **SIGHT** (Acts 9:18).

PAUL THE APOSTLE NEVER forgot his own conversion, found in Acts 9:1-22. It was the day when Paul was DELIVERED from the POWER of DARKNESS, and TRANSLATED into the kingdom of God's only Son (Col. 1:13), just like every Christian.

As believers, our PURPOSE is to be a LIGHT to the LOST, "...to OPEN their eyes, and to TURN them FROM darkness TO light, and FROM the power of Satan UNTO God, that they may receive FORGIVENESS of sins, and INHERI-TANCE among [US] [BELIEVERS] which are SANCTIFIED [SET APART; TO MAKE HOLY; PURIFY] by FAITH that is IN [CHRIST]" (Acts 26:18).

All who are <u>saved</u> are **PARTAKERS** of the <u>same</u> **COMMON SALVATION**: "Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the **COMMON SALVATION**, it was **NEEDFUL** for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should **EARNESTLY CONTEND** for the **FAITH** which was **ONCE DELIVERED** unto the saints" (Jude 1:3).

There are no other salvation experiences found in the Word of God other than this **COMMON**

SALVATION. They HEARD the Word, they were CONVICTED, they REPENTED, and "...by ONE SPIRIT are we ALL baptized into ONE BODY...and have been ALL made to DRINK into ONE SPIRIT" (1 Cor. 12:13).

All other <u>salvation experiences</u> are **COUNTER-FIETS**, <u>designed</u> to have "...men's persons in admiration" (Jude 1:16).

The **BLIND MAN** cried out, *"Jesus, thou Son of David, have* **MERCY** *on me"* (Mark 10:47). Have you ever prayed a prayer like that?

Jesus said, "What wilt thou that I should **DO** unto thee? The blind man said unto him, **LORD**, that I might receive my sight. And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way, **THY FAITH** hath made thee **WHOLE**. And **IMMEDIATELY** he received his sight, and **FOLLOWED JESUS** in the way" (Mark 10:46-52). What a glorious portrait of his salvation, and he never forgot it!

Do you remember when **YOU** were <u>translated</u> from **DARKNESS** to **LIGHT**? The <u>MAN POSSESSED</u> <u>WITH DEVILS</u> was found "...sitting at the feet of



Jesus, **CLOTHED**, *and in his* **RIGHT MIND**" (Luke 8:35), and he never forgot his experience!

The <u>PUBLICAN</u> never forgot his conversion! Jesus said that he, "...went down [FROM JERUSALEM] to his

house **JUSTIFIED** *rather than the other*" (Luke 18:9-14).

The <u>THIEF ON THE CROSS</u> said to Jesus, "...Lord, remember me when thou comest **INTO** thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Very I say unto thee, **TODAY** shalt thou **BE WITH ME** in **PARADISE**" (Luke 23:42).

The <u>ALMOST THREE THOUSAND SOULS</u> that were saved on the day of Pentecost surely knew when "...*they were pricked in their heart,*" and asked, "*Men and brethren*, **WHAT SHALL WE DO**?" (Acts 2:37-47).

A <u>CERTAIN MAN LAME FROM HIS MOTHER'S WOMB</u> was saved "...at the gate of the temple which is called **BEAUTIFUL**...walking, and leaping, and praising God" (Acts 3:1-8).

Space doesn't allow to tell of the Gentile <u>CORNELIUS</u> (Acts 10:25-44), or the jailer who asked Paul and Silas, "...*Sirs, what* **MUST I DO TO BE SAVED**" (Acts 16:16-34)?

There is only <u>ONE ANSWER</u> to that question: "Believe ON the Lord Jesus Christ, and THOU shalt be SAVED, and THY house" (Acts 16:31).

Let me ask <u>YOU</u>: did you <u>GIVE UP SELF</u> when you became a Christian? "...the kingdom of heaven is like unto **TREASURE** hid in a field; the which when a MAN [MALE OR FEMALE] hath FOUND, he HIDETH, and for JOY thereof goeth and selleth <u>ALL THAT HE</u> <u>HATH</u>, and buyeth that field" (Matthew 13:44).

Is that what **YOU** did? Paul said, "...*what* **THINGS** *were* **GAIN** *to me*, **THOSE** *I counted* **LOSS** *for Christ*" (Philip. 3:7). Can **YOU** say that?

Very FEW PEOPLE are TRUE <u>Christians</u> because "...STRAIT IS THE GATE [NARROW FROM OBSTACLES STANDING CLOSE ABOUT], and NARROW IS THE WAY [TO CROWD], which LEADETH unto LIFE, and FEW THERE BE THAT FIND IT" (Matt. 7:14).

Therefore, "<u>Examine yourselves</u>, whether YE be IN the faith" (2 Cor. 13:5), "for MANY are CALLED, but FEW are chosen" (Matt. 22:14).
