From the humanistic position, you might declare that we are in a tough time period in our lives. But I submit to each of us that God is a winner, and He doesn't allow anything than cannot be defeated. What looks unconquerable in our eyes can be defeated as long as we believe in the one who has kept us. We were not asked to seek the kingdom just for exercise but to show our faith in the one who is the kingdom. We became saved so that we can demonstrate that we believe that Jesus conquered death.
