

# **Eligibility**

Women are eligible for these services if they meet **both** of the following criteria:

- Are pregnant, parenting dependent children, or are attempting to regain custody of their children and
- Are in need of substance abuse prevention or treatment services

Women can access VCSB services through open access at our Main Office on Monday, Tuesday, or Thursday from 8am - 3pm. 540 887-3200

For urgent medical concerns, women are directed to call 911 for immediate medical assistance.
