Danceartists promotes a nurturing environment which is safe and welcoming of diversity at all times.

We are a non-competitive classical ballet training academy where mutual respect and encouragement in a positive environment is the standard. Our detailed Training Programs are prepared for training at both our physical Studio location in Shrewsbury and our Virtual Online Studio.

About Our Facilities

Our class sizes are small to ensure that each student receives individual attention in their training. Our daily sanitized large 47 x 29 ft studio with Wi-Fi is equipped with state of the art Marley Sprung Floor System, full length wall mounted mirrors, remote control sound and computer systems, large display screens, air-conditioned and heated premises, with wall mounted hand sanitizer stations. Recently renovated with a newly designed entrance with large comfortable waiting area for parents, and a large outdoor waiting area with extra large parking area right at the door in a quiet yet convenient open tree studded location. 2 Spacious separate students dressing rooms and 2 large separate 3 cubicle student bathrooms with double sinks stocked with 2 sanitizer soaps dispensers and paper hand towels dispensers. We care about the safety and happiness of our students and families and offer exceptional training programs by qualified faculty in a positive studio environment which fosters self confidence and a work ethic founded on happiness. From September 1, 2020 Danceartists daily training program schedule also includes an extra 15 minute transition interval between lessons.

In addition to our beautiful Studio location, we also offer our Danceartists comprehensive online training taught from our state of the art online studio with Zoom conferencing through our secure, closed network. Danceartists online training will be used at the discretion of Danceartists to ensure the safety of students and families. Danceartists online training is available to all our registered students. Students will receive the schedule with applicable links to each class by email. We're very proud of our students' happy focus and progress in all our training programs.

Snow Days and Cancellations

In the event of inclement weather, Danceartists follows the local Worcester/Shrewsbury school closings. Classes will be held online when schools are closed. In the case of government directives, Danceartists classes will be held online. Please look up cancellations at http://www.cancellations.com. Classes missed due to inclement weather and/or illness can be made up by attending other scheduled classes. Please email Danceartist's to arrange suitable make up lessons for your child. No credits or refunds for cancellations. However, there are many make up classes to select from and when necessary, Danceartist's will add extra lessons to the weekly schedule. Lessons missed due to illness may be made up by attending another class by arrangement with the director when a doctor's certificate is provided.

If your child misses lessons due to another chosen activity or vacation, Danceartist's will endeavor to find a lesson for your child to make up their missed lesson. However, Danceartists is under no obligation to do so. Danceartists reserves the right to cancel any classes or change the faculty teacher on short notice. Classes canceled by Danceartists may be made up by attending another scheduled lesson.

Code of Conduct

Students/Parents/Adults are expected to conduct themselves in an orderly, polite manner at all times while at the Danceartist's Ballet Academy premises, performance venues, and examination venues. It is cause for immediate dismissal from Danceartist's if a parent is deemed to have behaved in an aggressive manner towards students and or staff and faculty or has filmed students and faculty without their permission. For the safety and well being of our students, staff, and faculty Danceartist's reserves the right to refuse service.

Parents are required to understand and abide by the laws of Massachusetts regarding surreptitious electronic recording of conversations between people who have not consented such as in an office or public setting. Unauthorized or illegal recordings of conversations can be cause for a civil lawsuit for invasion of privacy. Parents are expected to explain the legal responsibilities of cell phone use in a public place to your children.

Student cell phones are to be turned off or silenced during class.

All the performance and costume fees are non-refundable and must be submitted before or by the due date.

Chewing gum, food and drinks excluding water are not permitted in the studio. Water is permitted in the studio and students may bring their water bottles into the studio with them.

Class viewing at Danceartists Ballet Academy is allowed during two separate "Open weeks". Parents may also view classes by making individual appointments throughout the year. Please do not stand in the hallway to watch classes. This is a distraction to both students and teacher.

Please mark your child's full name on every piece of ballet attire and any other personal belongings which your child may bring to the studio. Please DO NOT bring valuables to the studio. Danceartists is not responsible for any items lost, stolen, or damaged on the studio premises.

Photography or videography is prohibited at Danceartists - including any Danceartist's Ballet Academy performance or dress rehearsal regardless of location due to copyright restrictions associated with music, choreography, and costumes.

Parent/Teacher conferences are available if you have questions or concerns regarding any aspect of your child's experience at Danceartists Ballet Academy. Please schedule conferences with the director by email or phone.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition rates are based on the full 42 week discounted tuition rate basis of \$15.00 per hour group class rate when 42 weeks are attended. Subsidized classes begin at 295 hours of attended training hours per 42 week year. Danceartists 2020/2021 class schedule begins September 1, 2020 and concludes June 30, 2021. Danceartists has a 42 week training year.

Tuition is due in full upon execution of this contract. There are optional payment plans outlined below, but the tuition is in consideration of holding a spot open for the student in our studio which guarantees small class sizes and in the event the student is unable for any reason to complete the school year, the full tuition is still due and unfulfilled classes are kept in credit as make up classes for future use either in person or online. Class credits are valid for a maximum of 2 years.

Payment Methods

Check, all major Credit and Debit Cards, Money Order, Cash, Paypal, Square, Venmo

Option 1

Full year tuition one-time payment (2.5% discount when paid by June 24th), plus \$50.00 registration fee per child

Option 2

Full Year Tuition paid in 10 monthly installments is due on the 1st day of each month. First month is due with completed registration forms plus \$50.00 registration fee for each child. Please note that all monthly payments are due by the 1st day of each month from September 1, 2020 to June 1, 2021 and all installments must arrive *before* or *on* the 1st day of each month. A \$20 monthly late charge is added for all installments which arrive to Danceartists after the 1st day of each month. Please note that all Private Coaching (PC) classes must be paid in advance, if a PC has not been paid for the PC cannot go ahead. Tuition unpaid for 30 days will prevent the student from attending classes until the account is current.

Family Discounts

First Child \$15.00 per hour; 2nd sibling 25% being \$11.25 per hour; 3rd sibling 33% discount per hour being \$10.50 per hour. *Please note a Flat rate of \$15.00 per hour up to 294 hours applies per family before the sibling discount applies.*

Dance Expression Class ages 3 /4/ 5 Limited size to 8 students maximum \$13.00 per class

Ongoing Enrollments

Tuition is pro-rated from the date of the new student's first Class.

Minimum Class Programs

Danceartists Littlies Preschool Dance Expression Program 3-4 years - 1 lesson per week

Danceartists Junior School Ballet Training Program 5 years - 2 days per week

Danceartists Ballet Program from Intermediate Foundation upwards is minimum 3 days per week being 3 set classes and 1 Pointe or Pre-Pointe Class - Conditioning Limber and Contemporary classes are recommended for the serious student.

Please note that to qualify for consideration for pointe work, a student must be attending 3 days of classes per week for 3 years to build the necessary foundation for safe pointe work and be a minimum Bone age of 12. Bone age is determined by your medical practitioner.

Private coaching bookings available only when booked and paid for the full year in advance. Please note the different prices for private coaching booked and attended for the full training year and private coaching booked and attended for less than the full training year.

\$45.00 per half hour (30 minutes) solo private coaching when booked and attended 42 weeks \$80.00 per hour solo private coaching when booked and attended 42 weeksAll other Private Coaching Lessons booked but attended 41 weeks or less are \$75 per half hour/\$150 per hour.

^{*}Lessons missed by students can be made up only when a signed doctor's certificate is presented

^{*}Danceartist's does not make up lesson times booked when student attends other events at their booked lesson time.

^{*}Danceartists may reschedule lessons missed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances if Danceartists is closed.

^{*}Private coaching time availability is limited. So, early booking is recommended

Grievance Procedure

Should you have a grievance associated with your child's or your own experience at Danceartist's Ballet Academy please explain the nature of your grievance verbally or in writing to Danceartist's Ballet Academy personnel most directly involved. Please note that any action taken (formal or informal) will be handled in a private, co-operative, and dignified manner.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Transport to and from Danceartist's Ballet Academy is the responsibility of parents/guardians. At drop-off, parents need to bring their children inside the building to class. At pick-up, parents must come inside the building and pick-up their children from the waiting area. Students must wait for parents/guardians inside the building in the designated waiting area.

All parents, students are required to follow the social distancing, hygiene and health regulations as directed at https://www.mass.gov

Students must follow hygiene protocol upon arrival and on entering each class.

Parents are asked to be punctual when picking up students after class. Junior students are asked to sit quietly and watch the next class until their parent arrives. Danceartists is not responsible for students outside of their lesson times. However, faculty will not leave a student by themselves at the studio after closing time. Should unforeseen circumstances arise where a parent cannot arrange transport for their child after classes, Danceartists faculty will endeavor to make contact with the parents and emergency contacts. However, if contact is unsuccessful, Danceartist's will provide supervised transport home for the student. Costs for transport remain the responsibility of the parent. Extra child care time outside your child's class hours at Danceartists are Billed at \$25 per hour.

Dress Code

All students are expected to maintain a neat appearance and to abide by the specified dress code. Leotards, tights, leg warmers, are available at all dance stores. A list of stores in Massachusetts is available at the office and on our website.

Lower School Girls

(Primary to Grade 4) Tank leotard white/pastel pink, pink ballet tights, pink ankle socks, canvas ballet shoes. Hair secured in a bun.

Lower School Boys

(Primary to Grade 4) Black lycra cotton dance shorts, white fitted T shirt, white ankle socks, black or white canvas ballet shoes.

Upper School Girls

(Intermediate Foundation Upwards) White/pastel pink/black of any style. Plain colored chiffon ballet wrap skirts in matching leotard. Please choose one pastel and one dark. White, light gray, pink leg warmers. Bloch's vari-ation half tutu provided on loan from Danceartist's. Canvas ballet shoes, Demi-Pointes and Pointe shoes and character shoes where applicable.

Upper School Boys

(Intermediate Foundation upwards) Black fitted boy's/men's ankle length leggings or black tights and/or black lycra dance shorts, white fitted T shirt or boys/men's leotard, white or black leather ballet shoes, white ankle socks only.
