MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, June 8th, 2017 in the Municipal Office in the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with all councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on May 11th, 2017 were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of May were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council acknowledged receipt of a road ban and a number of road open notices. Council decided that there will be no hay salvage program in 2017 and that the municipal personnel will be performing the "top cut" on roadways in the municipality commencing the week of June 26, 2017. Council authorized the purchase of a Husqvarna Zero Turn Mower and to offer the 2007 New Holland Zero Turn Mower for sale by tender. Council authorized a grant to the fire department to help with operating expenses and set up a road tour.

Public Works Foreman, Andy Girard, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of way applications were approved by council for wellsites, an approach, a powerline crossing, and pipeline installations.

Correspondence was received and filed.
