At the beginning of the year we discussed all things Australian to celebrate Australia Day! We also explored Chinese New Year with some fabulous dragon/lion dancing using our borrowed lion costume. The children were able to watch and copy the Chinese lion dancing on the TV.

These types of experiences broaden the children's knowledge of the world around them as they gain an understanding of diversity that exists in our community (Outcome 2 of EYLF).

In response to some of our children's interest in the beach and Cohen and Jackson's fishing experiences, we set up our 'Under the Sea/Beach' dramatic play corner with our blue boat and fishing rods to practice our fishing with. This has been a popular area to engage with and explore – as we learnt about the diversity of like in our oceans.

Another interest of the children's has been spiders and insects. We have provided an insect and spider discovery table with a variety of insects and spiders, books and pictures to explore. We found some real spider webs to investigate in our yard as we discussed whey the spiders make webs and what kind of food they eat. We are learning about habitats and new vocabulary such as camouflage. This relates to Outcome 2 of EYLF — Respect and Understanding of the Natural World.

We have also make some wonderful grass heads from Kristy's left over wheat. The grass gew so quickly that all the grass heads needed a hair cut!

We are still enjoying a quiet 'rest/sleep time' in our room after lunch, so please send along some cot sheets. They will be left in our sheet bins if you need to take them home to wash. Thank you!
