## RESOLUTION OF TOWN OF FARMINGTON - ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF TOWN ROAD - TOMAHAWK TRAIL

I introduce the following Resolution and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the following real estate have dedicated said property to the Town of Farmington, to be used for public road purposes, and

WHEREAS, the public road/street is described as follows:

A parcel of land located in the Northeast ¼ of the Northeast ¼ and the Northwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 32, Township 22 North, Range 11 East, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin. Bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 32; thence S00-14-34W, 300.00 feet along the East line of the Northeast ¼ of Section 32 to the point of beginning; thence continuing S00-14-34W, 66.00 feet along said East line; thence N90-00-00W; 904.00 feet; thence S59-27-30W, 1182.75 feet; thence N90-00-00W, 465.00 feet to the start of a 65.00 foot radius cul-de-sac; thence along the arc of said cul-de-sac on a chord which bears N00-00-00E and is 66.00 feet in length to the termination point of said cul-de-sac; thence S90-00-00E, 446.98 feet; thence N59-27-30E, 1182.75 feet; thence S90-00-00E, 922.30 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel of land contains 181,296 square feet (4.1620 acres) of land more or less. Subject to all easements and restrictions of record.

WHEREAS, the Town Board has inspected the road and found it to be in compliance with Town Board road standards.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the above described property is accepted as a public road/street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the above described property shall be placed on the official Town map.
