1 Absent

## 2. Minor Puppy Bitch - Any Colour (7, 2Abs)

1 Babester & Holmes' Kalispell Karry On. Nicely presented golden baby of just over 6 ½ months, pretty head with correct pigment and a dark eye, good reach of neck and well placed shoulders, square in outline with thickly padded neat feet. Moved happily with enthusiasm BMPIS.

2 Yates' Abilou's Chamber Of Secrets. Blue roan of 7 months, sweet head, good forearm well bodied, happy disposition with a wagging tail. moved well.

#### 3. Puppy Dog – Any Colour (3, 1)

1 Mason's Sandlauga Jack Frost. Black and white ticked lad of 11 months, masculine head, built on traditional lines, well bodied, good ribbing with depth of chest and bend of stifle. Moved with drive.

2 Stapley's Shirepark Marsalis Magic. Blue roan of nearly 12 months, happy boy, dark eye, short coupled, moved well.

#### 4. Puppy Bitch – Any Colour (4, 2)

1 Harrison's Lourisma Shabby Chic. Cobby blue of 9 months with an attractive head and dark eye, well proportioned body with lovely legs and feet, good set on of tail, tidily presented, moved happily and enthusiastically . BPIS

2 Sutton's Shirepark Lacey Hays. Pretty headed blue girl of nearly 12 months, ultra short compact body, neat feet, good bend of stifle, well presented in good coat, movement difficult to assess.

#### 5. Junior Dog or Bitch - Any Colour (8, 3) Lovely class.

1 Goodall's Kalispell Beaspoke. A new one to me but he certainly impressed. Mature looking blue roan male of just over 12 months, lovely head of good proportions with a kind expressive eye, strong neck leading into a well-balanced body with depth and correct angulation fore and aft with excellent width over his back end. Stood on strong legs and tight cat like feet. Moved with positivity and drive and improved with each class, looked like he could keep going all day. I could imagine him doing a day's work. Beautifully presented with a gleaming jacket and well handled. Best In Show, congratulations!

2 Nicholas-Steele & Nicholas' Kalriziennes Zazzle. Feminine blue bitch of 13 months, built on smaller lines but nicely put together, lovely neck leading to well-placed shoulders and a firm level topline, tiny neat feet, used the ring with gusto and parallel movement. Unlucky to meet 1.

1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Integrity. Black dog with a lovely outline, short, compact body and good depth and width of chest, well boned legs and good width of thigh. Moved with drive. RBIS

2 Holmes' Kenan Krumpet. Feminine black bitch with a joyous disposition, pretty shaped head, nicely angulated, short backed, neat legs and feet, happy mover.

# 10. Special Graduate Dog or Bitch - Any Colour other than Black, Black/Tan or Golden (2)

1 Burley's Suedons Pippin for Barnspur. Blue roan male, balanced head, good depth of chest and spring of rib, well shaped backend. Moved ok.

2 Needham's Merryhaze Marguerita Time. Orange roan bitch, feminine head with a dark eye, good width of chest, nice shoulder placement and good length and angle of return of upper arm, was in a naughty mood and so rather unsettled on the move.

#### 11. Post Graduate Dog or Bitch - Any Colour (1)

1 Varnam's Shanaudvarn Lady Winnie. Black bitch, pretty feminine head, good depth of chest and nice wide rump. Coat not at its best, moved ok.

#### 12. Bred By Exhibitor - Any Colour (8, 1)

1 Nicholas-Steele & Steele's Kalriziennes Zhulily. Dark blue bitch, litter sister to 2nd in Junior and similar remarks apply. Very pretty head with an attractive soft eye, deep chest, neat feet, straight hocks, decent bone, moved well with drive. BOS

2 Morris' Riondel Manhatton Transfer. Masculine dark blue dog built on bigger lines, attractive head with a good depth of muzzle, well boned and angulated body with big ribs, neat feet, moved with vigour.

1 Shinkfield & Lester's Quettadene Cosmopolitan JW ShCM. Black dog with substance and body, good depth of chest with elbows well tucked in, well off for bone, wide back end, good turn of stifle. Moved with purpose.

2 Varnam's Shanaudvarn Ray of Sunshine. Gold dog, tidy looking, kind head and eye, level back, good set on of tail, moved ok.

3 Mason's Sandlauga Scot's Rescue

16. Special Open Dog or Bitch – Any Colour other than Black, Black/Tan or Golden (4, 2)

1 Nicholas-Steele & Steele's Marquell McCready by Kalriziennes TAF. Blue roan dog with an expressive eye, well boned, tidy compact feet. A little heavy over the shoulders but has a good outline, well presented, moved straight and true.

2 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Bring Me Sunshine. Orange roan bitch with plenty of substance and nice angulation didn't hold her topline on the move as well as 1, moved ok.

#### 17. Veteran Dog or Bitch - Any Colour (9, 1) A lovely class of veterans.

1 McCaffrey's Glenntree Miss Tantalizer at Chaysonnie. Attractive black & tan bitch of 7  $\frac{1}{2}$  years, good reach of neck with well angulated shoulders, excellent spring of rib, neat feet, straight back and held a level topline on the move, which she did with great enthusiasm. In lovely coat and condition BVIS

2 Morris' Riondel Manhattan Serenade ShCM. Blue roan dog of nearly 12 years young, in great condition for his age, well muscled and happy, moved out with purpose.
