Upon this ROCK, I will BUILD my church... Day Star Publications

"In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast <u>hid</u> these things from the <u>wise</u> and <u>prudent</u>, and hast <u>revealed</u> them unto <u>babes</u>: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight" (LUKE 10:21).

Jesus said unto his disciples, "...whom <u>SAY YE</u> that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, <u>Thou art</u> <u>the Christ, the Son of the living God</u>. And Jesus answered and said unto him,

Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood <u>HATH NOT revealed it unto thee</u>, but my Father which is in heaven. And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter [A PIECE OF ROCK], and upon this rock [A MASS OF ROCK, CHRIST HIMSELF] I will <u>BUILD</u> [TO BE A HOUSE-BUILDER; TO CONSTRUCT] my <u>CHURCH</u> [A CALLING OUT {FROM DARKNESS}]; and the gates of hell shall not <u>pre-</u> vail against it [TO OVERPOWER IT]" (MATTHEW 16:15-20).

Jesus is the **ROCK** spoken of throughout the Old Testament. He is the **FOUNDATION** that **NO MAN** can substitute (1 COR. 3:11); He is also the foundation on which a house stood, and the rain, the floods and the winds beat upon that house, and it **PREVAILED**, "...for it was founded upon a **ROCK**" (MATTHEW 7:25).

Jesus began to build His church on the day of Pentecost after the Holy Ghost entered the world and united 120 disciples of Jesus into <u>ONE</u> body (Acts 2:1-4). After Peter preached the gospel...by <u>FAITH</u>, "...*there were* <u>ADDED</u> unto them about three thousand souls" (Acts 2:41). And from that day to this, the Lord has "...<u>ADDED</u> to the church <u>daily</u> such as should be saved" (Acts 2:47).

Jesus said to his disciples <u>before</u> the day of Pentecost that the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, would come. He is in the world on a singular mission: to <u>**RE-PROVE**</u> the world, that is, <u>prove us to be in error</u>, and <u>urge us to repent to God</u>, and "...as many as received him, to them gave he <u>power</u> to become the sons of God,

even to them that <u>believe on his name</u>: which were BORN, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but <u>OF GOD</u>" (JOHN 1:12-13).

The building process of <u>the church of the living God</u> has continued since the day of Pentecost. <u>We</u> are God's "<u>building</u>" [ARCHITECTURE; A STRUCTURE] (1 COR. 3:9). "...<u>WE</u> are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones" (EPHES. 5:30), "For by <u>ONE</u> Spirit are we <u>ALL</u> baptized [UNITED] into <u>ONE</u> body" (1 COR. 12:13).

Every person the Lord adds to his church is "...<u>quickened</u> [TO CAUSE TO LIVE; TO MAKE ALIVE; TO GIVE LIFE], who were <u>dead</u> [A CORPSE; SEPARATION] in trespasses and sins; wherein <u>IN TIME PAST</u> ye walked <u>according to the course of this world</u>... among whom also we <u>ALL</u> had <u>our</u> conversation <u>in times</u> <u>past</u> in the lusts of <u>our</u> flesh, <u>fulfilling</u> the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were <u>BY NATURE</u> the children of wrath, even as others.

<u>BUT GOD</u>, who is rich in mercy, for <u>HIS GREAT</u> <u>LOVE</u> wherewith he loved us, <u>even when we were</u> <u>dead in sins</u>, hath <u>quickened us together with</u> <u>Christ</u>, (by grace ye are saved;) and <u>hath raised</u> <u>us up together</u>, and made us <u>sit together</u> in heavenly places <u>IN</u> Christ Jesus: That in <u>the ages to come</u> he might show the exceeding riches of his grace <u>in</u> <u>his kindness toward us</u> through Christ Jesus" (EPHES. 2:1-7).

Every believer remembers when they were once in darkness, and how they were "<u>quickened</u>," that is, made <u>ALIVE</u> by the <u>TRUTH</u> of the gospel. If your eyes have been opened, <u>you know it</u>. If you have turned "...<u>from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God</u>" (Acts 26:18), you KNOW IT.

We "...are <u>BUILT</u> upon the <u>FOUNDATION</u> of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself <u>being</u> <u>the chief corner stone</u>; in whom <u>ALL</u> the <u>BUILD</u>-<u>ING</u> fitly framed together <u>GROWETH</u> unto an holy temple in the Lord: <u>In whom ye also</u> are <u>BUILDED</u> together for an <u>habitation</u> of God <u>THROUGH</u> the Spirit" (EPHES. 2:20-22).

Jesus is the Chief corner stone: the foundation stone, that marks the **BEGINNING** of the building, the essential, most important position, for Jesus said, "...*I am the* way, *the* truth, *and the* life: NO MAN COMETH unto the Father, <u>BUT BY ME</u>" (JOHN 14:6).
