My dear parishioners,

We are living a unique moment in the life of the parish. We have been part of the Church of Newark since 1854 and for the first time we experience not being able to worship together because of the pandemic that is affecting the whole world. It has been hard on all of us not to see the familiar faces that we have grown accustomed to see each Sunday, in every parish event, in CCD, in our Festival. However, we have also been blessed with the possibility of transmitting via YouTube our masses, adoration, Angelus, A Minute with God, Rosary. Also, thanks to the Zoom application we have been having Bible Study in English and Talleres in Spanish. I know that this does not replace to have each other and see each other, but it has been a consolation. I am aware of your desire to see your parish reopen and some of you have directly asked me.

At the beginning of the month, I had a phone conversation with our Archbishop Cardinal Tobin and manifested your feeling, and he told me something that consoled me: We will not be closed one minute more of what is needed for safety – I am paraphrasing. A few days ago, pastors received a survey about reopening and procedures, and we were informed that a task force to establish reopening procedures was in place.

For this reason, on Monday May 4, I called a meeting with the Trustees of the Parish, Finance Council, Pastoral Council, DRE, Youth Minister, Head of Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers in English and Spanish and Coordinators of Altar Serves to discuss a contingency plan to reopen the parish in all levels pending the guidelines from the Archdiocese. It was a very productive meeting that formed 3 committees to help establish those procedures: one for First Communion celebration (CCD), one for Youth Ministry and one for Parish office/liturgies. All the committees are working hard to have a plan and as soon as the Archdiocese gives us a formal guideline, we will adapt ours so that we can start serving you in person again. We understand that the process will be slow but at the same time I invite all to be patient.

On May 11, we had our second meeting of the Reopening Committee and we also received directives from the Archdiocese about reopening in three phases. We are happy to announce that Phase 1 will start on Monday May 18. Church will be open for private prayer on Mondays from 2pm to 4 pm, Wednesdays and Fridays from 9 am to 11 am. Please remember to always wear a mask when you are in church. Please pray for all those who have died during this Pandemic and those who are still sick and struggling that they may find consolation in the Lord.

May God bless you all. Saint Francis de Sales – Pray for us!
