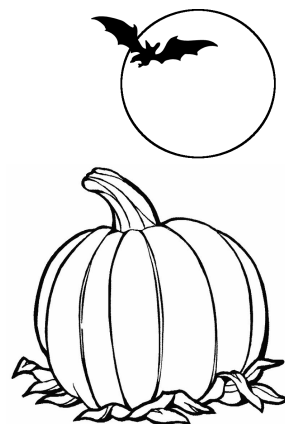

Notes from September AGEA meeting

Senator Bryan Simonaire spoke about the Legislation that passed. You can read more here: simonaire.com/legislation.html#Bcorps

Delegate Ned Carey spoke about the Anne Arundel County 311 app to submit a concern or report an issue. He mentioned that depending on which cell tower your phone is pinging to, you may get Baltimore City 311. They are supposed to be able to connect to Anne Arundel County.

There was a discussion about abandoned vehicles and vehicles with out of date or missing license plates. Office Bethea said he would look into and take care of as some of the vehicles are already tagged.

Officer Bethea spoke about the Citizen's Police Academy, which provides Anne Arundel County residents 21 and older the opportunity to learn about laws, police procedures, forensics, crime scene collections, resource management and more. This is a free 16 week program. The next Academy will take place on in the Spring of 2019. Learn more here: aacounty.org/services-and-programs/citizens-police-academy

The Vice President of our association, Caren McPatter was chosen to sit on the Anne Arundel County's General Development Plan Citizen's Advisory Committee. The Committee will be responsible for providing input to the Office of Planning Zoning as they continue development of Plan 2040. The Commission consists of a Chair, citizens from each of the seven County Council districts, as well as representatives from the environment, building, education, and planning sectors.

The Woodfall Greens apartments on Hammonds Lane have started taking applications and the first section completed will be ready this November.
