<u>Membership</u>: 2020 Membership = 136, Lifetime = 115 with a total paid to date of 251. Most of 2019 (268) still pending renewal. Will continue sending out email advising members the range is open and reminder to renew membership for 2020.

Range reports:

- Summation: Most ranges have received much needed maintenance (thanks to Jerry, Don, Pete and Brad-mowing). Most ranges could use more boards and Pete said he will replace where needed. Ralph continues to monitor broken targets (mostly on the .22 range) and is repairing and replacing as needed. The entire range needs more signage and Pete has offered to make and post signs which can also be interchangeable.
 - Archery Range Ralph W. requested an archery specific workday for both the existing archery range and the new walk-through range in development. The workday will be held July 10 at 8:00 a.m. Bring your small battery-operated hand tools if you have them.
 - **Trap** Wednesday trap shooting is still going strong with lots of shooters in attendance. The clay pigeons that were ordered have arrived and are stored in the shed where the lawn mower is housed. Also, they have purchased some patches as small rewards for shooters this year.

Other discussion on placing a gate at the entrance to the 100-yard range on Wednesdays during trap and on other special occasions with instructions to use the Auxiliary range. Gate will be locked in the upright position when not in use. Motion to approve 1st. Jim D., 2nd Bob R., motion approved.
- Practice Trap The 2nd practice has been installed on the new practice trap range and is fully functional. Some minor adjustments are needed, and we are working on a shelter. There is also some landscape maintenance to be done and debris to be moved. Jim D. has offered to get a Bobcat to help with these issues.

• Old Business:

- **Billboard Highway 63** Natasha F. brought some more samples to view for the billboard and members viewed and voted on the ones they liked. Natasha will finalize and update more at August meeting.
- Website The website is still under construction (behind the scenes) bringing the entire site from their old platform to their new platform. The delay now is the transferring of pictures.
