This full-bodied Chardonnay is aged in oak with no residual sugar. This dry white finishes nicely with a hint of vanilla.

On the label you will find an artist rendition of a picture my son took of the farm house from our upper parking lot. The wisteria in the foreground are originally from the Aca Packer mansion in Jim Thorpe. This painting was featured at one of our Pour and Paints that we frequently host at the winery in partnership with The Next Picasso.

The name, One Year In, celebrates the first of our four new wines that was ready to be sold after our first anniversary.
