> The Word of God is also known as THE PER-

FECT LAW OF LIB-ERTY. Man is not to live by bread only, "...but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the Lord" (DEUT. 8:3): not out of the mouths of men, because:

"Every word of God is **PURE**: he is a shield unto them that PUT THEIR TRUST in him" (PROVERBS 30:5).

Many who read the word of God are like "...a man beholding his natural face in a glass: for he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was" (JAMES 1:24).

The Word of God is this "glass" or "mirror" that shows our "natural face" but, after hearing, we

tend to ignore our true nature. This "mirror" is a collection of books that tells us how sinful we *really* are.

"But whoso looketh into THE PERFECT LAW OF LIBERTY, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be **blessed** in his deed" (JAMES 1:25).

Most people live a very "religious" life, and feel content by doing good deeds, but, "pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit [RELIEVE] the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world" (JAMES 1:27). How do you measure up?

> We, through the pride of our outward appearance, "... will not seek after God: God is not in all [OUR] thoughts" (PSALM 10:4). Since we will not seek God on

our own, God seeks us through His Word. He wants us to "...serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind" (1 CHRON. 28:9).

God's "mirror" shows mankind that his heart is desperately wicked, for out of the heart "...proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies" (MATT. 15:19).

It is man's nature to do evil, "for all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23). "...There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they

are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one" (ROMANS 3:10-12).

God is very clear about the state of man's condition: "...there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not" (Eccles. 7:20). Man NEEDS a Savior to keep him from the judgment, because "...all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone" (REv. 21:8).
