

Explanation of Care

Monthly base fee includes:

- Calm, clean and quiet living environment
- A team of equine professionals
- Feeding of grass hay
- Feeding of supplements and other food that are provided by the owner
- Automatic watering system or monitored water system
- Daily monitoring
- Routine daily care that includes oral/topical medication administration and routine wound care as instructed by vet
- Exercise according to Vet instructions
- Enrichment with Vet approval
- If needed, assistance with Vet, Farrier, or other practitioners
- Immediate response and follow up care as needed for unexpected events
- Comfortable bedding (shavings or straw)

One-time admission and discharge fee:

- Sanitization of stall and equipment and use of shavings upon admission and discharge
- Intake with owner and Veterinarian before horse arrives on the property to insure accurate and detailed instruction is received by the rehab staff

Additional Treatment Options That Can Be Done with Vet Approval

- Massage or bodywork session
- Kinesiology taping
- Chiropractic
- Acupuncture
- Cold laser treatment
- P.E.M.F. session
- Shockwave therapy
