Legacy Grant Eligibility Criteria and Application Process

1. Parent must be a graduate of Southern University.
2. Parent must be a financial and active member of the Southern University Alumni – Houston Chapter.
3. Applicant must attend Southern University as a full-time student.
4. Essay – the essay should be one page, typewritten and double spaced.
 - a. High School Seniors: Describe your college plan - Why do you wish to attend college? What field of study do you intend to pursue? How do you plan to utilize your degree?
 - b. Upperclassman (*select one topic*): (1) Describe your college experience and/or how you plan to distinguish yourself as a leader. (2) Explain the importance of your chosen profession in society. (3) How do you define success? (4) How have you worked in your life to make a positive difference?
5. Grant application and essay must arrive in one package. Incomplete application or application package will not be considered and notification will not be made.
6. The deadline to submit a grant application is on March 15th. Application and essay may be e-mailed to recruiting@houstonjaguars.com. Application package submitted or postmarked after the deadline will not be considered and notification will not be made.

8. Grant awards will be announced by April 15th. Grant awards not to exceed \$500. A limited number of grants available. Grant awards are based on availability of funds.
9. Grants will be disbursed in the fall or spring semester. Recipient must submit proof of full-time enrollment during the academic year (fall/spring) or forfeit the award. Payment of grant will be made directly to the recipient after proof of enrollment has been established.
