Then at last he will let you go. 21 And I will cause the Egyptians to look favorably on you. They will give you gifts when you go so you will not leave empty-handed.

What will it take for your release from bondage? - Luke 11:20-22 (KJV)

- 1. Know that God understands where you are Exodus 3:7-13 (NIV, NLT), Exodus 4:10-15
- 2. Knowing that God has given you authority over your situation Exodus 3:10-13 (NLT)
  - a. Don't protest against the command of God Exodus 4:10-15 (NLT)
  - b. Don't be afraid of your enemy
- 3. Knowing who you represent Exodus 3:14-15 (NET)
