Start a conversation

Sample Questions	Sample Responses
Are you registered to vote?	You are? Great! What's your biggest concern? (e.g. student financial aid, health care, jobs) Here's your <u>E-Z voter checklist;</u> <u>match your goals to voting issues</u> . Ask your friends and family to register, too.
You're registered to vote already, aren't you?	No? No problem! It'll just take a couple of minutes; here's the form. In the meantime, I'll get your <u>voter checklist</u> ready so you'll have all the information in one place. Please post it on social media and tell your friends.
Is your voter registration-up-to-date?	Not sure? Let's check right now. Here's a voter reference card in the meantime. Please text a copy to 3 friends while I get an update for you.

More conversation = better chance of voter *TURNOUT*

Additional questions	Additional conversation tips
What are your top three concerns these days?	Once you identify your goals, you can more easily identify the candidate whose positions will help you meet YOUR goals. Here's your <u>E-Z voter checklist</u> .
Do your friends, parents and siblings vote?	Here is an extra voter checklist to share. You can download more at beavoter.info.
You're not yet eligible to vote?	No worries! You can still be a voter ambassador and ask your friends and family to vote.
Did you know that you can get paid to be a poll worker?	Here is the information to sign up. Provide a form if you have one or a website link to your local elections site.
