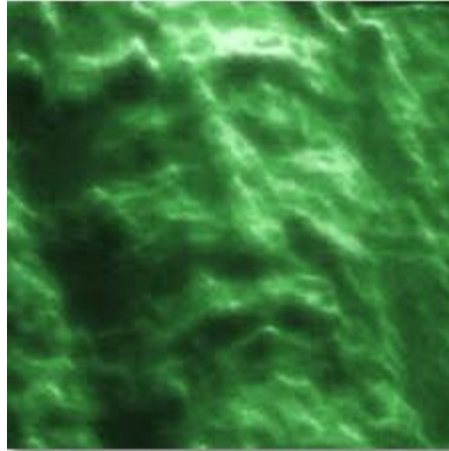


THE FIRST SELFIE EVER MADE

The very first self-portrait ever made was a full body image taken by a dead man at the very second of his resurrection. This self-portrait was imprinted digitally in 3D, in the form of a hologram on a linen cloth, a flat 2D medium and penetrating only the top layers of the fibers of the cloth without soaking it. Using a 3D image analyzer on a picture taken of the cloth, scientists were amazed to see a 3D image of a man's



face in front of them. The full body image printed on the cloth was not distorted even though the body was lying on a stone floor and the cloth was wrapped and folded around the body. Distortion could not have been avoided if the body was lying on a stone slab when the image was taken; therefore, the person must have been lifted from the floor, suspended in mid-air and the cloth pulled taut in all directions from the head to the feet at the time the portrait was taken to avoid any distortions in the image, a real event horizon comparable to that at the surface of a black hole, a new beginning.

There is so much depth in the 3D image that one can clearly see the cuts carved on his back by the cat-o-nine tails, the Roman scourge called in Latin a flagrum or flagellum. It is obvious that he was whipped mercilessly; his back, his chest, his buttocks, the back of his thighs, and the back of his legs all show cuts, lacerations and blood spots made by whip marks and two or three sharp objects. There is a nail hole in the wrist of the hands as shown by the blood spots. There is also a spear hole on the side of the body as marked by the pile of blood. There is a ring of blood spots around the head, especially in the back and top of the head revealing that a crown of thorns were driven into his head cutting into his skin to cause it to bleed.

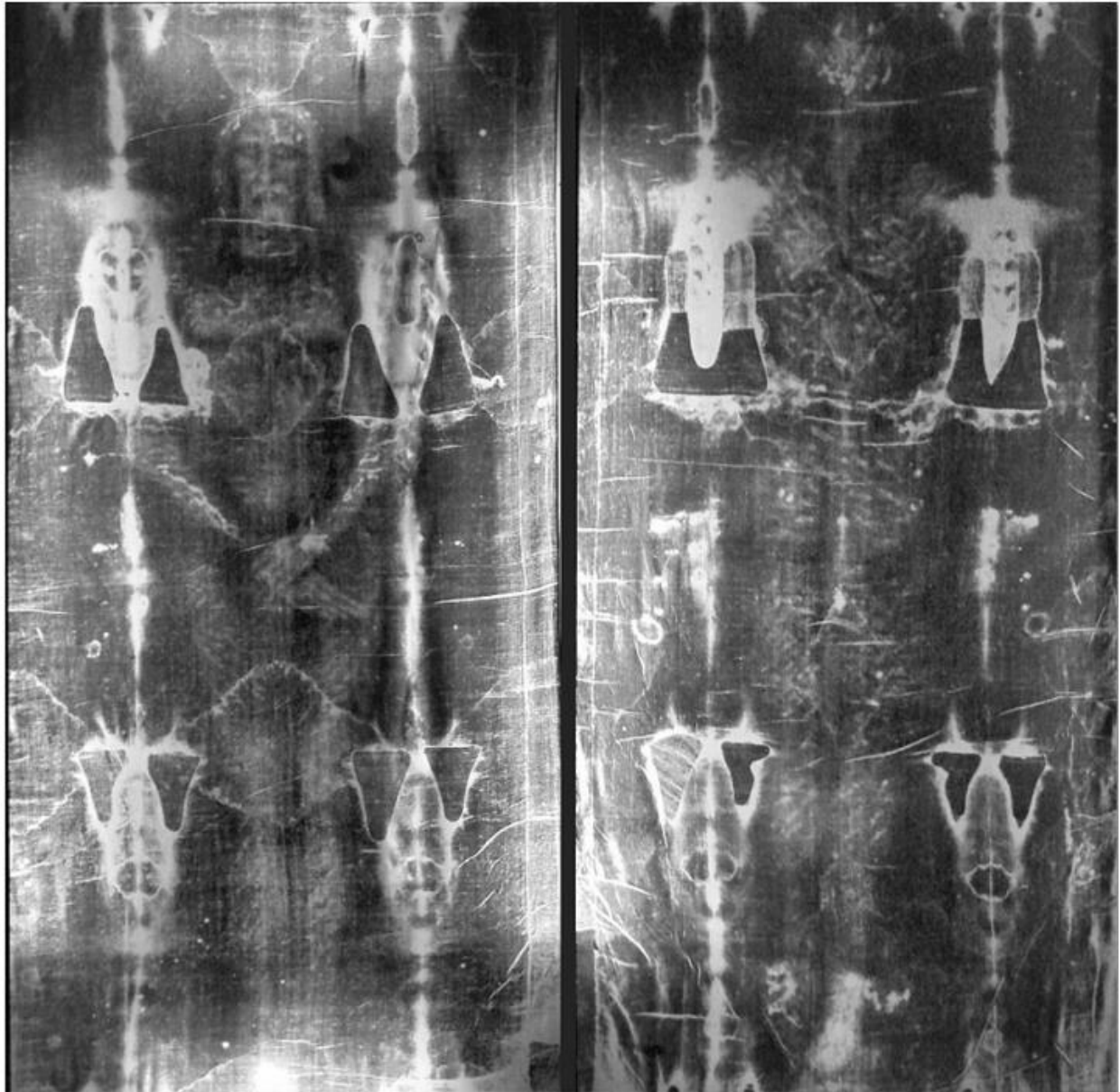
Jesus therefore took a self-portrait, a selfie, printed on his own burial shroud and left it for us to see and believe that what we read in the bible is true and verifiable. It is clear that he willingly offered himself to be scourged, crucified until he died and his death was verified by thrusting a spear through his side. Jesus knew that he will be scourged and crucified until he died because he predicted his suffering to his disciples in the gospels. In Matt. 20:17-19, GOD'S WORD Translation we read:

¹⁷ When Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem, he took the twelve apostles aside and said to them privately,

¹⁸ "We're going to Jerusalem. There the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and the experts in Moses' Teachings. They will condemn him to death ¹⁹ and hand him over to foreigners. They will make fun of him, whip him, and crucify him. But on the third day he will be brought back to life."

Jesus knew his suffering and death was coming and included it in his plan for our redemption before it actually happened. He told his disciples in John 16:5-7, GOD'S WORD Translation:

⁵ "Now I'm going to the one who sent me. Yet, none of you asks me where I'm going. ⁶ But because I've told you this, you're filled with sadness. ⁷ However, I am telling you the truth: It's good for you that I'm going away. If I don't go away, the helper won't come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you."

His plan for the redemption of man was actually conceived from the beginning of the world and proclaimed at the time of the transgression of Adam and Eve in Genesis 3. This plan was encoded in the first genealogy of the Bible in the meaning of the names of the generations from Adam to Noah in Genesis 5.

His plan for the redemption of man is also encoded in his own name YHVH. The name YHVH was first mentioned in the second chapter of Genesis, the first book of the bible. We read in the Names of God Bible, Genesis 2:4, 7:

⁴ This is the account of heaven and earth when they were created, at the time when **Yahweh Elohim** made earth and heaven.

⁷ Then **Yahweh Elohim** formed the man from the dust of the earth^[a] and blew the breath of life into his nostrils. The man became a living being.

In the first chapter of Genesis the creator God was called Elohim. The creator God who formed man in Genesis 2 is Yahweh Elohim or YHVH Elohim or Adonai Elohim or the Lord God. The word Adonai is used out of respect by some people, because they believe the name is too holy to pronounce. However, God himself gave us that name and it has a simple, powerful meaning that proclaims to us how much God really loves us.

God's name YHVH in Hebrew is made up of consonants pronounced as Yod-Hey-Vav-Hey. Yod is a pictogram for Arm and hand or deed. Hey is pictogram for Lo or Look or Behold. Vav is a pictogram for Nail.

When we put it all together YHVH is saying, ðArm and hand behold, nail behold.ö In other words, behold or take a good look at my arm and hand, specifically at my wrist, and behold or see the nail or the nail marks of my crucifixion. It is saying behold the sign of how much I love you and what I am willing to do to redeem you. Hello, take a good look at my hand/wrist and observe the nail holes on my hand/wrist and see my nailed hands/wrists and ankles/feet hanging on a cross, my back torn into shreds by many stripes for your healing; my head bleeding from the crown of thorns redeeming you from the curse of the fall in the garden; my heart pierced and ripped open by the spear through my side paying for all your debts, for all eternity. Therefore, his name actually means, ðI am your redeemer, I love you and I am willing to pay the price, any price, for your sins, even with my very life, suffer all the humiliation, the gruesome torment and die for you, for everyone, for even those who took part in my torment and death. My hand/wrist is your proof, your evidence that I have paid all your debts in full.ö This promise was declared as early as Genesis 2:4 before he created man in Genesis 2:7.

His plan of redemption has also been encoded in the meaning of the pictograms of the Hebrew Alphabet from Aleph to Tav, Based on the derivation of this author, encoded in the pictograms of the Hebrew alphabet is the declaration:

The strong first leader of the house lifts up with pride, the door (of) infinity (Jesus) to reveal, show, or behold the nail, a weapon to cut off the fence surrounding the deed, the work done (so as to) allow learning, (and the) control of chaos (so) life activity can turn, see and know, open its mouth and speak of the righteous last Adam destroyed on the cross as a sign (for our redemption). Remember Jesus said: "I am the door."

Attached at the end of this discussion is a document that shows how this declaration was decoded.

The Hebrew word for Mercy Seat in the Holy of Holies where the High Priest enters once a year to make atonement (at-one-ment) for the sins of the people of Israel also refers to the plan of redemption in its meaning testifying to the fact that Jesus Christ was crucified from the beginning of the world. The Mercy Seat in Hebrew is כפרת CAPPORETH meaning Like or according to  the bullock of sacrifice  on the cross , or according to the bullock sacrificed on the cross, referring to the redemption provided by Jesus Christ who was nailed to the cross. This meaning was first revealed by Joseph Prince in his Sermon

262, ðForgiveness Righteously through Jesusö, God is righteous in making the believer righteous, Part 2 of 3.

In Deuteronomy 19:15, New King James Version (NKJV) we read:

One witness shall not rise against a man concerning any iniquity or any sin that he commits; by the mouth of two or three witnesses the matter shall be established.

In Matthew 18:16, New King James Version (NKJV) we read:

But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that ‘by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.’

I have given you four different witnesses directly from the bible. You have the true meaning of YHVH, the story buried in the meaning of the names of the genealogy from Adam to Noah, the story told by the 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet, and the meaning of the Mercy Seat. All woven together, declaring loudly that Jesus Christ, the true God, planned from the foundation of the world to offer himself as a sacrifice to redeem us from the dominion of Satan into his marvelous kingdom because he loves us.

The selfie on the shroud of Turin is clear evidence that he took the self-portrait to let us know he did what he had promised to do even before he created man. He knew Adam was going to fail and he made the proper provision to restore us back to himself and left a selfie, after he did it, as proof that it is finished. The cross could not bind him; death could not hold him; Satan could not keep him; and grave could not stop him; he is the one and only triumphant YHVH, Jesus Christ.

God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for he himself is fair and just, and he declares sinners to be right in his sight when they believe in Jesus.
