2018 was a busy but exciting year! On May 19, we competed at Celebration Talent Competition held at the Weidner Center in Green Bay.

We are blessed to say that our competition went extremely well! The girls' hard work all year paid off and we took home some amazing awards. Our 6<sup>th</sup> Group routines "Throne Room" and "Beloved" both received a Gold placement.

Our Pep Elite Hip Hop routine "Download" received a High Gold and Second Place overall score. Our Pep Elite Contemporary routine "Broken Things" received a Platinum and First Place overall with a special performance award given by the judges!

We also had three soloists: Hannah Weidner, who placed High Gold; Haylee Whiting who placed High Gold and received a special performance award from the judges; and Emma Howey, who placed Platinum, received First Place in her division and was chosen as a Dancer of The Year Finalist with an invite to nationals. Emma then competed at Wisconsin Dells for nationals July 11-16, taking workshop classes, performing her solo, and performing in a production routine of "The Greatest Show" from the *Greatest Show Man* with other Dancer of the Year Finalists from various regional events from Wisconsin and many other states! She received a High Gold for her solo, and we are so proud of her hard work!

On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, we held our 17<sup>th</sup> annual spring recital at the Oconto Falls PAC, where our beautiful dancers of all ages took the stage to show what they had learned during our program. We are so proud of all our dancers and our instructors! 2018 was a great year, and we are looking forward to the same blessings in 2019!

# Help your child succeed!

Here are some fantastic ways to help your child succeed in dance!

- Make sure they attend every class!
- Record them during parent observations so they can easily practice at home with a video.

- Parent Observations are held the last classes of January, March and May.
- ✤ January Parent Observations are January 28 and 29.
- Second tuition payment is due on or before Saturday February 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please leave payments in pink holder.
- Thursday February 7: First Workshop Event (times and groups listed on the previous page) Please sign up in the entrance on the appropriate workshop sheet. There is no extra cost for workshops! If you know of anyone who is not a dancer at CDC, but is interested, please give them my email. Thanks!
- Wednesday February 20: Final shoe and attire order of the year will be held in the lower level. If you are looking to order new ballet shoes, jazz shoes, tap shoes, tights, attire, etc. you may do so on this night. First, Second and Third Group were only sized for one pair of shoes. You will need to come this night to be sized for your second pair. If there are any free, gently used shoes, we will have them out for you to take. You can come anytime from 4:00-7:00 PM. If you are ordering shoes, your dancer must be present so that we can fit him/her correctly. Please keep in mind there will be no more orders following this date!

# Attendance!

Make sure your child is attending class every week! Our attendance policy is listed in the handbook. We want everyone to perform for the recital but our program requires great commitment. You are only allowed to miss a certain number of times.



Please check your handbook for specifics, please inform the instructors if your child will be absent, and keep track of the days they miss.

Note From Mrs. Tina:

As we find ourselves in the thick of winter, we just want to remind everyone to please walk on the perimeter of the room by the chairs (and entrances) and not through the middle of the dance floor. Please keep an eye on little ones as well so our floor stays clean and safe for our dancers! Only dance shoes should be in the middle of the floor. Thank you for your help!

### COSTUME TRY-ON

It's that time of the season! Costumes are starting to come in and we need to make sure that everything fits. Please keep in mind that dance clothes are meant to be form fitting. We always order based on your child's measurements, however, these are not custom-made costumes. We always err on the side of caution and will order a size larger if a dancer is in between two sizes. Please keep in mind that we order from various companies, so while your dancer may be in one size for one costume, they may take a different size in another costume.

- First Group's Monday class will be trying on at least one costume next Monday, the 14<sup>th</sup>, in the lower level at 4:00 PM before class begins.
- > Sixth Group and Pep Elite will be trying on costumes during class.

All other groups need to come on <u>Thursday January 24<sup>th</sup></u> to try on costumes. Please come at the appropriate time frame according to the group your dancer is a part of. If you cannot bring your child, a family member or friend can bring them. We do need a parent present. Only women will be allowed to stay when the costumes are being tried on.
