ones that will see and usher in the return of the Lord Jesus Christ.

We are living in a time when mankind has more light and revelation on God's plan of creation and salvation than ever before. In fact, humanity has already received everything they are going to get in the way of light and revelation from God prior to Jesus' second coming. It is all there for the whole world to see. Well then, don't they see? The answer is no, they don't, at least not without some help. That's where you and I come in.

In **I Corinthians 1:18**, the Apostle Paul declares, "For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who

are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God." NKJV. It has been appointed unto men to preach the Gospel. Without men preaching, they will not know. The book of Romans makes that very clear. In **Romans 10:14-17**, the scripture says:

14 How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? 15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written:

"How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!"

16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "LORD, who has believed our report?" 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. NKJV

Those in the world cannot see unless they first hear. That is what flips the switch: that is what turns the light on. While I am a strong advocate of the Gospel being preached from the pulpit, it is not that preaching that will get the masses saved. It is the preaching one on one, a Christian simply telling a family member, a loved one, a coworker, a neighbor, even a stranger in a God planned encounter, that God loves them. That Jesus shed His Blood for them, that they too can be saved by "calling on the Lord." You see, the power is in the proclaimed Gospel. Proclama-

tion is simply stating what God has done from a believing heart. If we tell them that, God will do the rest, He will confirm His Word, especially the Good News of what He has done through the gift of His Son.

In **Ephesians 6:19** Paul said to pray "... that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel,.." **NKJV**
