Every day we should walk in the favor of God. Mary was positioned to receive the favor of giving birth to God's son, Jesus the Christ, because she was obedient. The only requirements she needed were to carry the son of God was to be obedient and line up with the prophetic Word of God. The only thing we need to qualify for God's favor, is to be obedient and be in alignment with the prophetic Word of God.

To walk in the favor of God, we must:

1. Meet The Minimum Qualification - Luke 1:26-28, 34 (NIV), Isa 7:14 (NIV)
 - a. Mary qualifications as a virgin and in the lineage of David
 - b. Mary was willing to be used by God

2. Agree With God When You Don't Understand – Luke 1:29-38 (NIV), Matt 1:18-26 (NIV)
 - a. Mary agreed with the will of God
 - b. Joseph agreed with the will of God

3. Expect God Will Accomplish His Word – Luke 1:37-38 (NIV), Isa 55:8-11 (KJV), Duet 28:3-14 (TLB), Isa 1:19 (NIV), Jere 1:12 (AMP), Isa 1:18-20 (NIV, MSG, VB)
 - a. God's Word will never fail
 - b. God's Word will accomplish His purpose
 - c. God is actively watching over his Word
 - d. God will bless us according to His promise
 - e. God blesses the obedient
