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

In the big city of *Liberty*, when citizens buy tickets for the annual lottery, it is not to make money.


The BOAs who run this postapocalyptic society hope to win Bloodbags. Slaves. Human beings to whom they can drink for sustenance. Until death ensues.

The Kaleidoscope collection tells the hectic life of many students attending the same high school. With themes LGBTQ + in the background, each novel puts forward a different teenager.




James



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


The "Taboo" series for teens.

I do not ask much about life. I just want to be the best.

The best student, the one who always gets the highest score in the class, no matter the subject.

The best girl for my parents, who already have enough concerns with the firm, my brother hyperactive and lack of money.

The best friend for Katy, my best for always, although I know she uses me. And even the best "victim". One that has overcome the most terrible ordeal of her life: a kidnapping ... and no ill effects!

In short, I want to excel in everything.

Yet, somewhere in me, there is that voice that keeps telling me that I could be more-than-perfect. But how ? Stop eat, poor idiot.

The story of Annie is based on a true story.

Anorexia is not an absolute quest for thinness. It is the manifestation of a deeper malaise, the emergence of high-performance personality, which binds unrealistic goals (not only in terms of body image), which pushes beyond its limits for achieving and experiencing a constant feeling of guilt when doesn't succeed. In Canada, a teenager in three suffers from an eating disorder, and a hundred people die each year. The causes of anorexia are many and complex, even insidious, making it difficult to prevent. However, recovery is possible, even if it can sometimes be long.



Annabelle, my sister, says I'm her knight, sometimes her prince. No one is offended when I present myself as a boy, my friends and my family understood that my body is not all that defines me. I take testosterone, I look forward to be able to undergo my first surgery and I start college. Now, seventeen years, I am Eloi. I am happy, I am at peace, but I keep asking myself a question: is it that one day someone will want to be in a relationship with me?

Then there is Luka, a friend of Dominic, who invades my tranquility. He changes everything with his kind eyes and questions that I avoid. He is gay, like me. No ... not quite like me. But how could I tell him that I'm not exactly the one he likes? The more I get to know him, the more I want to be his prince to him. And unless I want him to know I'm transgender.

Finally, I realize that I still feel the need to hide to be loved.

Taking hormones, surgeries, government documents, first love relationship ... In this **following to "Tomboy"**, the author continues to discuss **transsexuality**, and above all the steps required by the people in transition. Accept your difference is not huge, but what it means later also takes a lot of courage.



Six months have passed since Lily survived the suicide pact she had made with her friends Frankie and Liz.

The young woman now thinks she put her life on track. The sequelae caused by the car accident fade, harmony is back in her family and she even found love in Tom's arms, her physiotherapist.

But a shadow still hangs over her head: that of the lie.

Evidence about the tragedy are made public, calling into question the innocence of Frankie. Lili will have to make a difficult choice: leave her friend take the blame and pass for a murderer in the eyes of all or confess her secret to her entourage.

Except that the truth can make her life to collapse ... again.

The <u>consequences of the lie</u> sometimes reveal an unsuspected gravity. This is what happens when you have to answer for actions in court. In this **following to "What does not kill"**, perjury may be heavy to carry for Lili. Beyond the legal considerations also loom ethical questions: sacrifice the tranquility of her relatives, even illusory, or preserve the memory of a loved one?



PRISONER OF SILENCE

I'm a normal teenager. At least, I was: fourteen years old, separated parents, three best friends, school ... Until now. One where my mother met Michael, her new boyfriend. At first, their romance had fairytale air. But soon, my mother began to change. She became secretive, not dressed like before, wore make-up all the time (even to clean!) And seemed always on the alert.

Suspicious, jealous, controlling ... Prince Charming of my mother was away from those I had known in the books of my childhood. Over time, the insults have become threats and slaps, and finally, shots. My mother never went out, she lied to her friends, do not answer the phone. Despite my pain and my revolt, the silence seemed stronger than anything. Until that terrible night when I finally found the courage to call for help ...

<u>Domestic violence</u> does not hurt that those who suffer, but also those who witness it, mostly children and adolescents. One might think that because of the seriousness of the situation and diversity of communication networks, it has become easier to confide, to denounce. But that's not counting the shame, guilt and fear that transform every day the family home in prison.



NO, IT'S NO!

Yes. No. The dictionary is quite clear on the definition of the two terms.

Yes: expresses a positive response to a query.


No: prefix expressing negation, contrast, REFUSAL.

That's what I tried to explain to Zackary, that night.
That I did not want! Even I shouted! NO! But for him, my answer meant nothing.

And now I am no longer a shadow of myself.

<u>Sexual assault</u> is a criminal act the least reported to the police. Why? Because the shame and fear overwhelm the victim. Because the victim must, in addition, to deal with stereotyping in the rape culture. Even today, this concept tells us "not to go out alone at night, otherwise we look for the disorder," "not to dress sexy, because it causes men", "not if we embrace is not ready to go all the way "," do not say no after having said yes. "
In our so-called advanced society, the burden of proof always belongs to the victim, not the aggressor. It is essential to educate our youth and to change the camp of shame.

Rather than teach our daughters what to do to avoid being raped, teach our son not to violate.



TAGuée

As a child I thought that sadness came along the dark and set off again at sunrise. Over time, I have come to realize that something was wrong with me ...

According to my doctor, I suffer from anxiety disorders. That may be why I always imagine disaster scenarios. He says it is possible for me to get out, to regain a normal life. But if I made fun of me in my new school? If I could not make new friends? When anxiety came over me, it rots my thoughts.

I know I'm not easy to live with. For other ... but also for myself. The people around me must think I'm crazy. They may be right.




TOXIK

How did I get there? How could I lose control of my life at this point, without realizing it? Everything worked very well for me. At school, with my best friend Elodie, with my family and in my hip-hop dance classes ...

I was convinced I was not a "drug addict". I started to consume only to improve myself, in a very specific context: my participation in a rap battle. I did it for the right reasons. And I knew that I could stop anytime. Well, that's what I though. Until the problems fall on me. One by one. Until it goes too far ... It was necessary that everything collapses around me so that I become aware of what was happening to me. Why did I let myself get so low?

In Quebec, more than a quarter of adolescents report having already taken drugs, from cannabis to harder substances. If pleasure is one of the reasons often mentioned, a new type of consumption has spread in recent years: the use of **drugs for performance purposes**. Kellyann's story highlights a different, but current, face of substance abuse.



UNDESIRABLE

At her old school, Melie was wanted by all guys and was not ashamed to seduce them, to have fun with them. Until a stupid video goes around ... Her so-called friends did not hesitate to exclude her, to insult her, to consider her as a whore. Now, she intends to start from scratch, erase the reputation that has been stuck to her and find a semblance of normal life. For that, she wants to regain her popularity.

For his part, Bastien is rejected and humiliated since the beginning of his high school. He has the impression that he will never find his place and will remain the excluded, the freak, the undesirable.

Then he meets her. But how could he please this kind of girl? Tired of being always alone, he decides that, this year, things will have to change.

Social rejection takes different forms and, unfortunately, no one is immune to it. No matter how it manifests, it inevitably hurts those who are victims and leaves painful scars, sometimes indelible. In the long run, it can have serious consequences for self-esteem, and even cause significant anxiety or depression problems. But, above all, the rejected people then live in fear, often visceral, to undergo a new rejection.










