AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC UPON THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WAUPACA COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Speed Limits.

- (a) The State Speed Limits Adopted. The provisions of ss. 346.57, 346.58 and 346.59 of the Wisconsin Statutes, relating to the maximum and minimum speed of vehicles are hereby adopted as part of this section as is fully set forth herein, except as specified by section 1 (b) of this ordinance pursuant to s. 349.11 (3) (e) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- (b) <u>Speed Limits Established</u>. The speed limits are established as hereinafter set forth upon the following streets and highways, between the limits designated:
 - 1. King Road, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.
- (a) Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with State Trunk Highway 22, easterly for a distance of 0.30 of a mile.
- (b) Forty miles per hour from a point 0.30 of a mile east of State Trunk Highway 22, to its intersection with Pryse Road.
 - 2. Otter Drive, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with State Trunk Highway 22, northwesterly to a point 0.20 of a mile south of its intersection with State Trunk Highway 54. $^{/}$

3. Pine Ridge Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Otter Drive southwesterly to its terminus at Taylor Lake.

4. Park Lane Drive, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with State Trunk Highway 22, northwesterly to its intersection with Park Lane.

5. Park Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Grand Army Road, northerly to its terminus.

6. Murray Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Grand View Road, westerly to its terminus.

7. Grand View Road, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q" northeasterly to its intersection with State Trunk Highway 22.

8. County Park Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its east intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q" northwesterly to its west intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q".

9. Whispering Pines Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q", southerly and westerly to the line common to Sections 32 and 33.

10. Pleasant Park Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q", easterly to its terminus at Round Lake.

11. Snug Harbor Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Cleghorn Drive westerly to its terminus at Long Lake.

12. Norris Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Smith Lane southwesterly to its terminus at McCrossen Lake.

13. Looksley Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Round Lake Road, south-easterly to its terminus at Browne Lane.

14. Round Lake Road, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q", northeasterly to its intersection with Smith Lane.

- 15. Smith Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.
- (a) Forty-five miles per hour from its intersection with State Trunk Highway 54, southerly to its intersection with Round Lake Road.
- (b) Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Round Lake Road to its terminus at Sunset Lake.
 - 16. Highland Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with State Trunk Highway 54, southerly to its terminus.

17. Hicks Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with State Trunk Highway 54, southerly to its terminus at Sunset Lake.

18. White Pine Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with State Trunk Highway 54, southerly to its terminus at Sunset Lake.

19. Cleghorn Drive, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q" southerly to the Dayton Town Line.

20. Browne Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Looksley Lane southwesterly to its terminus at Round Lake.

21. Halbert Lane, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q", northerly to its intersection with Grand View Road.

22. Miner Drive, Town of Farmington, Waupaca County.

Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Trunk Highway "Q", southwesterly to the Dayton Town Line.

SECTION 2. Penalty. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00 together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of the forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication or posting, according to law.
