

Girl hospitalized in what police say was gang-related stabbing

PORTLAND, Ore. - A stabbing that sent a girl to the hospital Tuesday evening was gang related, according to police.

The incident happened around 4:30 p.m. in the area of Southeast 122nd and Holgate.

When officers arrived, they found a juvenile victim who had been stabbed multiple times. She was transported to a hospital for treatment.



Witnesses helped officers track down the suspect, another juvenile female. She was taken into custody and charged in connection with the stabbing.

Police are not identifying either the victim or the suspect because of their ages.
