

Campsite Booking Conditions

Bookings are from 1.30pm on the day of arrival until 10.30am on the day of departure. Sorry - no arrivals are accepted after 8pm.

A non-refundable deposit of £50 per week or part week is required for each pitch booked

Site fees are due 6 weeks before the start of your holiday, unless agreed otherwise and are only refundable where we are able to re-let the pitch. If this is not possible then no refund can be made.

If you fail to arrive on the date you have booked then your pitch may be re-let from 10am the following day, unless we have been informed of your delay.

Please note that we are a family park and do not accept more than 6 people per pitch

Up to 2 well behaved dogs are welcome outside of 'high season' but must be kept on a lead no longer than 2 metres at all times please and never left unattended.

Only one dog per pitch is allowed in 'high season'.

All dog mess must be cleared up immediately and disposed of in the dog bins provided. Please don't walk dogs around the camping/touring areas; they should only be exercised in the dog field.

Barbecues are very welcome but do please keep them raised off the grass. Sorry - campfires are not allowed. You can bring a metal firepit but please don't burn wood as it smokes too much.

The speed limit throughout the park is 5mph.

All quiet by 10.00pm please. At all other times the enjoyment of others must not be compromised by excessive noise or rowdy/nuisance behaviour.

Parents are responsible for providing the appropriate supervision of all their children at all times whilst on the park.

Bikes are allowed on the site provided they are ridden slowly and with care. Unfortunately our terrain probably isn't best for scooters as it's quite stony.

We (the proprietors) reserve the right to refuse a reservation or to terminate a booking of any person whose conduct is deemed detrimental to the well-being or comfort of other park visitors or whose behaviour is deemed unacceptable by said proprietors. No refund of any fees paid will be given under these circumstances.

Extensions are subject to availability and may involve moving pitch.

We (the proprietors) cannot accept liability in respect of personal injury or for loss of visitors property however caused.

All visitors to the site must comply with the instructions of the proprietors in the interest of safety and comfort for all.
