 this will help get these 14 people back to Virginia.

Mark Seymour - Case Update

- Mark Seymour stated Human Rights Advocates received draft regulations. Mark does not feel these
 regulations will be ready by November 2015. We will continue to operate with the 2007 Human Rights
 Regulations that were updated in October 2014.
- Commissioner Deborah Ferguson resigned and Jack Barber is Interim Commissioner as of September 22, 2015. The Office of Licensing also has an Interim Director Cleopatra Brooks for over a year.
- CHRIS: All Human Rights Advocates have been asked to spend one day a week closing CHRIS reports.
 All the advocates were asked to close all pending cases and the number of cases was over 4,000 cases.
 Angela Harrison is now closing the CHRIS reports for all 18 Human Rights Advocates. The problem here is that Angela knows nothing about any of the cases.
