What Happens when a Human Being Dies?

he film industry has produced many movies displaying several versions of what happens after death. Movies like "A Christmas Carol" and "It's A Wonderful Life" show spirits talking to the living, or angels earning their wings by helping the living.

Other movies like "Ghost Dad" with Bill Cosby; the 1984 film "Field of Dreams" or the 2000 film "Gladiator" also demonstrate various ideas of what happens when we die.



"Ghost" was a very touching drama of two people, one alive and one dead, being able to <u>communicate</u> with each

other with the help of a <u>psychic</u>, while in "The Sixth Sense," a boy had the ability to speak to the dead, <u>delivering</u> messages to the living.



The latest new movie for this year is called "Hereafter," bringing yet another spin to the subject of what happens when we die.



But, in reality, men and women die everyday, as cemeteries do testify. What *really* happens when a *human being* dies, and what man or woman is *qualified* to tell us?



For instance, in Michigan, a group of teenagers, weighted down in a small compact 4 cylinder, sped past a line of cars, trying to beat an oncoming train. But they didn't make it. They **ALL** were killed instantly. <u>Where are they now?</u>

If you <u>sincerely</u> want to know the answer, don't seek answers from <u>religions</u>, because they do not <u>agree</u> <u>among themselves</u>. Don't ask men of great learning, because they are <u>conflicted</u> in their own <u>opinions</u>, while driven by their own <u>imaginations</u>.

The <u>Word of God</u> has **ALL** the answers to every question you may ask. It is the <u>owners manual</u> to mankind's existence, but man will **ONLY** believe in the <u>image</u> he sees in his mirror.

"God is a Spirit" (JOHN 4:24) and He <u>created us</u> in His image: "And God said, Let us make man IN OUR IM-AGE, after OUR LIKENESS...So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him;

MALE AND FEMALE created he them" (GENESIS 1:26-27).

We are spiritual beings, the offspring of God Himself: "Ye are GODS; and ALL OF YOU are CHILDREN of the most High" (PSALM 82:6).

When our bodies die, we <u>continue</u> on in our <u>spiritual bodies</u> because we are <u>eternal</u>, just like God is <u>eternal</u>. The question is, where will **YOU** spend <u>your</u> eternity?

God said in His Word, "...it is appointed unto men ONCE TO DIE, but AFTER THIS the judgment" (HEBREWS 9:27) that determines where you go. The choice is yours.

God spoke to Daniel the prophet, and he wrote down these words:

"And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall AWAKE, some to EVERLASTING life, and some to shame and EVERLASTING contempt" (DANIEL 12:2).
