## Covid-19 Summer Camp Update!

## There is some good news, so-so news, and some bad news.

Here is the most up to date information we can pass along for summer camp.

At this time the school has notified all the coaches that all Avon Facilities, including the tennis courts, will remain closed until June 30th per the DOE and the IHSAA.

That said, we will start tennis camp on July 7th.

If any future decision by the School, IHSAA, & DOE allows for us to start the camp by June 9th we will do our best to make that happen. Over 90% of the kids registered so far have registered for 1st and 2nd sessions (full season). However, I reiterate that July 7th will be the start of tennis camp.

When you register your child for camp, please email me their registration form, if possible. If not, please mail it to the high school. Instructions are on the form.

You can always go to www.avoncta.org to get the form. Click on tournaments, camps, the events page, and then click on the picture of summer camp 2020. If you had planned on doing both sessions, go ahead and circle "Both Sessions" on the form. If you only planned on registering for "Second Session," please sign up only for that session and circle one session. The reason we are doing this is to make sure we have the appropriate coaching staff ready if the guidelines change, and we can do the first session.

Do not pay yet! We have plenty of time to work that out. The prices remain the same regardless of the additional expenses we will incur for the camp.

We have applied for a USTA grant in hopes of purchasing bulk sanitizer, touchless payment methods, and items required to ensure a safe summer camp for the kids and the coaches.

We will send out camp guidelines/instructions to all campers once we have some more feedback from the USTA, School, State, etc.

Expect to have the following safety precautions regarding tennis camp:

touchless temperature checks

guidelines upon arrival of each camper

specific drop off and pick-up locations

Respect of State social distancing guidelines

We "may" need to modify the start time for the 9 AM classes to 8:30 AM. That would mean the class would go from 8:30 to 11 AM. These changes will depend on class sizes. Please remain patient and flexible during this new normal.
