The open house will allow our families the time to walk around your child's environment, play in their setting, meet the staff and ask as many questions as you want. It is very important that you remember to sign your kids in and out of procare. We do double check every day to make sure that children are being signed in and out and will fix hours. However the time that the staff are marking them in and out on the sign in sheets may not be the time that they left. This could create issues with billing, especially with our casual families. If you have forgotten your password come and see Erin or myself and we can reset it for you.

Please remember that the daycare closes at 6:00 pm. All children must be picked up and have left the daycare by 6:00 pm. Families will be charged \$1.00 per minute after 6:00 pm as it states in our policy.

Please remember to...

- 1) Have monthly planners in by the 20th of each month to ensure childcare for the following month!
- 2) All invoices are to be paid by the end of the month.
- 3) Clean out your child's cubby at the end of every week.
