Very Important Information! - Paying your childcare fees

If you are new to us then this information may be useful.

For Holiday Club bookings, your invoice due date will be a week before your care commences. If we can accommodate last minute bookings then your invoice will be due immediately.

For term time care adhoc bookings are due a week in advance and last minute bookings immediately.

For term time allocated places an invoice will be sent out on the 15th of each month and will be due by the end of the month - paying a month's care in advance at all times. Your monthly invoice must be settled in full by the due date in order for care to resume so childcare vouchers will need to be processed in good time!

Bookings must be made by close of business Friday (6pm) for the following week as our email is not always checked outside of working hours.

Then you may be pleased to know that they can come & join us during the Summer Holiday Club!

Your Reception Class starter is very welcome to attend our Summer Holiday Club which starts on July Wednesday 24th.

The online booking pack will be online around 4-5 weeks before the Summer Holidays start.
