A student's Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) record is created and the student is then issued a Form I-20 by the designated school official (DSO) at the SEVPcertified school they have chosen to attend.

Apply for Student VISA

Student brings their Form I-20 and other required documents to apply for a student visa from the U.S. Department of State.

Arrive in the United States

Student arrives no more than 30 days before their program start date and presents their Form I-20 and valid student visa to U.S. Customs and Boarder Protection at the port of

Report to School

Student must report
