Apply to Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP)-Certified School

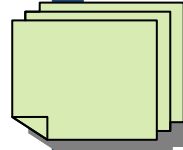
Student applies and is accepted to and SEVP-certified school.

Receive a Form I-20, "Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status"

A student's Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) record is created and the student is then issued a Form I-20 by the designated school official (DSO) at the SEVP-certified school they have chosen to attend.

Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee

Student must pay the I-901 Fee at Fmjee.com.

Apply for Student VISA

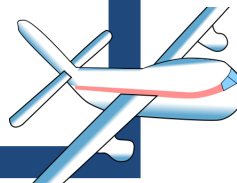
Student brings their Form I-20 and other required documents to apply for a student visa from the U.S. Department of State.

Arrive in the United States

Student arrives no more than 30 days before their program start date and presents their Form I-20 and valid student visa to U.S. Customs and Boarder Protection at the port of

Report to School

Student must report to school and show his/her VISA and I-20 and submit all registration paperwork to the Designated School Official.
