ORDINANCE NO. <u>06-19</u> (2000)

AN AMENDMENT TO THE TRUANCY ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. §9.06, of the Town Public Peace and Good Order Ordinance related to offenses by persons of school age is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

9.06 OFFENSES BY PERSONS OF SCHOOL AGE.

- 1) Definitions: (a) "TRUANT" means a pupil who is absent from school without an acceptable excuse under §118.15 and 118.16(4), Wis. Stats., for part or all of any day on which school is held during a school semester.
 - (b) "HABITUAL TRUANT" means a pupil who is absent from school without an acceptable excuse under §118.16(4) and 118.15, Wis. Stats., for part or all of 5 or more days on which school is held during a school semester.
 - (c) This section is adopted pursuant to §118.163, Wis. Stats. §118.163, Wis. Stats., is hereby incorporated herein and adopted by reference.
 - (d) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 to be a truant from school.
 - (e) <u>Dispositions</u>. Any one or more dispositional alternatives set forth in $\S118.163(1\text{m})$ are available to the Court.
 - (f) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 to be a habitual truant from school.
 - (g) <u>Dispositions</u>. Any one or more dispositional alternatives set forth in §118.163(2) for being a habitual truant are available to the court.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on and upon passage and publication according to law.
