"UNSUNG HEROES" (An LMMI Black History Project Suggestion)

<u>#1 - What:</u> Recognition of adults, ages 55 and above - from your church/neighborhood/community/organization — who have made noteworthy achievements/accomplishments - in any area - of which many persons are unaware (but should be made aware).

#2 - Organizers: Millennials, ages 18 – 37

- A) Formulate Committee; include specific assignments needed.
- B) Locate "Unsung Heroes" from your church (or as above).

#3 - Procedures:

A) Gather information/visuals, etc. about each "Unsung Hero:"

Advertisements, then Presentations through:
Church bulletins; Meals; special programs; hard/soft
media [protecting confidentiality, etc.]; Sunday Service;
personal interviews; Honorariums/gifts/cards, etc.

B) Organize/Do the specific details, including deciding where/how recognitions will be done.

#5 – Evaluate.

NOTE: Black History does not have to culminate at the end of February – nor does it have to occur only during one month of the year.
