“UNsung HEROES” (An LMMI Black History Project Suggestion)

#1 - What: Recognition of adults, ages 55 and above - from your church/neighborhood/community/organization – who have made noteworthy achievements/accomplishments - in any area - of which many persons are unaware (but should be made aware).

#2 - Organizers: Millennials, ages 18 – 37

A) Formulate Committee; include specific assignments needed.

B) Locate **“Unsung Heroes”** from your church (or as above).

#3 - Procedures:

A) **Gather information/visuals, etc. about each “Unsung Hero:”**

Advertisements, then Presentations through:

Church bulletins; Meals; special programs; hard/soft media [protecting confidentiality, etc.]; Sunday Service; personal interviews; Honorariums/gifts/cards, etc.

B) **Organize/Do the specific details, including deciding where/how recognitions will be done.**

#5 – Evaluate.

NOTE: Black History does not have to culminate at the end of February – nor does it have to occur only during one month of the year.
