## **Come OUT from Among Them...**

hen the children of Israel were wandering in the wilderness, a man named **Korah**, along with a great number of other men, decided they were "just as holy" as Moses and Aaron, and challenged to join the priesthood too.

Soon after, they enticed the entire congregation of Israel, and together they opposed Moses and Aaron, even "... unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: and the glory of the Lord appeared unto all the congregation" (Numbers 16:19).

God spoke to Moses, telling the congregation to...
"... <u>Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs</u>, lest ye be consumed in all their sins" (Numbers 16:26).

While Korah and his followers stood <u>defiant</u> in their challenge against Moses and Aaron, "... <u>the ground clave</u> <u>asunder</u> that was under them: And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their houses, and all the men that appertained unto Korah, and all their goods. They, and all that appertained to them, <u>went down ALIVE</u> into the <u>PIT</u> (which is <u>HELL</u>), <u>and</u> the earth closed upon them: and they perished from among the congregation" (Numbers 16:1-35).

Today, world religions continue to stand defiantly against the **TRUTH** of God's holy word and through much **covetousness**, deceive millions of people worldwide. Scattered among some of these religions are *true* born again believers.

But now, "... knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed" (Romans 13:11).

God has commanded all believers to "Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? ... as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord..." (2 Cor. 6:14-18).

The Grace of Almighty God that brings salvation <u>has appeared</u> to <u>ALL</u> men, but many have chosen to ignore His gift of eternal life through forgiveness of sins.
