The Enhancement Foundation, Inc., is a nonprofit corporation operated exclusively for charitable, inspirational, educational, and scientific purposes as approved by the IRS as an exempt organization from 25 federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c) (3). Donors can deduct contributions they make to the Enhancement Foundation under IRC Section 170. We are also qualified to receive tax –deductible bequests, devises, transfers or gifts under Section 2055, 2106, or 2522. A copy of our organization's exemption letter to resolve questions on our exempt status can be made available. The IRS has determined that the Enhancement Foundation is a private foundation within the meaning of Section 509(a). The Enhancement Foundation, Inc., was established in 2012 by its' Founding CEO Ms. Brenda Campbell to support the quality of lives, value and contributions of women in every aspect of their daily living. WHEREAS, TEF sends ambassadors to raise social consciousness about programs, resources, and training to empower women to mitigate distractions from their personal and professional goals; and



She went on to study music and English at the University of Missouri-Kansas City.



Motherhood compelled the vocalist to pursue a reliable income, so she found office work while still singing on weekends. Eventually, **Rucker** found demand as a guest performer on gospel albums by artists including **Edwin Hawkins, Myron Williams,** and **Jerome Greene.** Continued guest spots, along with increased exposure provided by **Dorinda Clark-Cole (the Clark Sisters)** within COGIC, led to more live performance opportunities and a livelihood as a professional musician. In 2007, a series of strokes nearly ended **Rucker's** life, much less her career aspirations, but she returned to the stage as soon as her recovery would allow, and self-released an eponymous album in 2009.

Corbett: is the Founding CEO for Social Butterflies Foundation, a registered 501c3 non-profit organization dedicated to helping lupus and fibromyalgia survivors and their families (www.socialbutterfliesfoundation.org). Chastity is passionate about helping lupus survivors live healthy lives. While research for a cure is of the utmost importance, many need immediate assistance. Therefore, she founded the Social Butterflies Foundation. This is an organization dedicated to ensuring that lupus and fibromyalgia survivors know that they are not alone. It provides resource information, support groups, educational conferences, college scholarships, and emergency medical financial assistance. For Chastity, lupus and fibromyalgia awareness is not just a month, it is a movement. Chastity was diagnosed with systemic lupus in 2005. She is a strong advocate for awareness and is known to many as "The Lupus Conqueror". She has endured several medical complications such as pneumonia, pulmonary embolism, a mild stroke, epilepsy, and more due to the illness. Yet, she still stands! Despite her own health challenges, Chastity continues to make time to uplift and encourage others.

She attributes this to her strong Christian beliefs and faith. Chastity graduated Summa Cum Laude from Norfolk State University earning her Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and Master of Arts in Criminal Justice. She served as the Founding President of the Graduate Student Association ensuring that graduate students had a voice on campus. Chastity is a proud member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. and the Order of Eastern Star- Prince Hall Affiliation. Chastity believes in being a blessing to others, and you will always see her smiling. She is married to Richard Corbett and mother of three sons: Ashar, Savon, and Shemar. She is also a proud grandmother: Syncere and Serenity. Spending time with her family is her greatest joy.

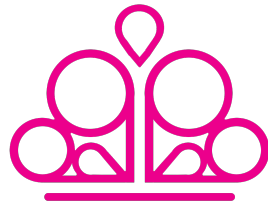

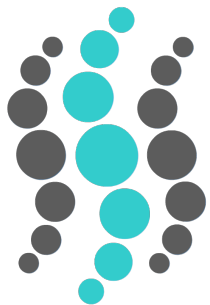

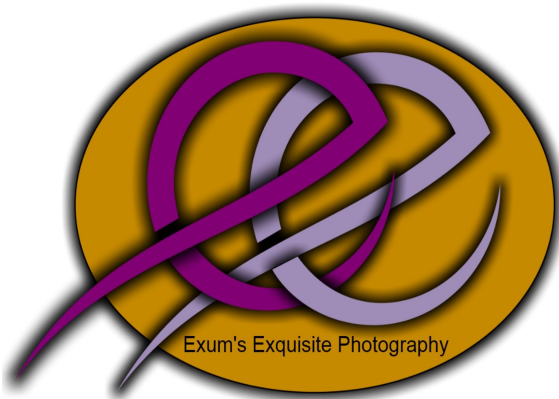
