## ORDINANCE No. 6/18/18(2018)

## An Ordinance to Adopt an Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Farmington

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

**SECTION!:** Pursuant to Section(s) 62.2361.35/60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Farmington is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The Town Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the document titled Ordinance #08-07-07(2007) An Ordinance to Adopt the Town of Farmington Year 2030 Comprehensive Plan as the Town comprehensive plan on August 7,2007.

**Section 3.** The Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire Commission at a meeting held on June 18, 2018 recommended to the Town Board the adoption of an amendment to implement Farmland Preservation as part of the comprehensive plan.

**Section 4.** The Town published or posted a Class 1 public notice and held four public hearings regarding the Farmland Preservation plan amendment

**Section 5.** The Town Board of Farmington, Wisconsin hereby adopts the proposed Farmland Preservation plan amendment.

**Section 6.** The Town Clerk is directed to send a copy of this ordinance and the Farmland Preservation plan amendment to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes

**Section 7.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board and publication or posting as required by law.
