Apollo Trophy 2017 Artistic Competition

Announcement

- ORGANISING BODY:** Iceworld Figure Skating Club Inc., affiliated to Ice Skating Queensland Inc.
- DESCRIPTION:** Apollo Artistic is an artistic competition.
All skaters **must** submit their entry forms direct to the CLUB (IFSC) online and not via ISQ.
- VENUE:** Iceworld Olympic Ice Rink, 1179 Beaudesert Road, ACACIA RIDGE Qld, 4110.
- ICE SURFACE:** The dimensions of the ice surface are 60m x 26m.
- DIVISIONS:** **Apollo – Singles and Groups (up to 4 skaters), Mens & Ladies can be combine in a divisions below**
Division A: Aussie Skate (Freeskate 1,2,3,4)
Division B: Preliminary
Division C: Elementary/Basic Novice A
Division D: Basic Novice B/Intermediate
Division E: Advanced Novice/Junior/Senior
- NB Levels may be grouped depending on the number of entries.
- With regard to “Groups” of up to 4 performers in an entry where the skaters are of different levels, then the division corresponds to the highest level in the group. (e.g. a group consisting of two skaters in preliminary and two skaters in pre-primary, will compete in the pre-primary division).
- DATES:** **Friday 7th and Saturday 8th April 2017**
- TIMES:** Starting times will be advised after the close of entries.
- DRAW:** Draws for initial Start Order will take place on **Friday 31st March 2017 at 6.15pm** at the rink.
- ENTRIES:** **Entries must be submitted via the ONLINE entry form ONLY @ www.ifsc.org.au and must be received prior to the closing date. All entries must be accompanied by full payment to be valid. (Payment is to be made via online entry system)**
- NB** **No Late entries will be accepted.**
Should you require assistance with regard to the online process you should contact the club before the 25th March 2017.

Closing date for entries: Thursday 30th March 2017

ENTRY FEES:

Apollo Entry Fee for Singles	\$45.00
Apollo Entry Fee for Groups (per group)	\$60.00

Withdrawals: Refund – only with medical certificate – a 10% deduction from the entry fee before the draw and **no refunds for withdrawal after the draw** on 31st March 2017.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: All competitors must be a member of their local club and ISQ, or alternatively, a current 2017 Aussie Skate member skating at a Queensland ice rink.

MARKING:

6.0 system will be used for all levels. Closed marking will be used

Medals/Trophies:

Will be awarded to first three place-getters in each division.

MUSIC

NB** 2 copies of each music programme must be supplied as follows:

- be provided on Compact Disc,
- contain only one track per CD
- be marked with:
 - competitor's name,
 - division (e.g. Junior Ladies)
 - program description (e.g. "Apollo Artistic")
 - exact running time of the music (not skating time).
 - **NB no adjustments will be made to the level of the track during the competition**
