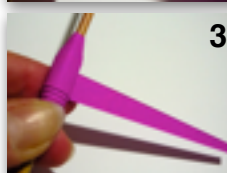
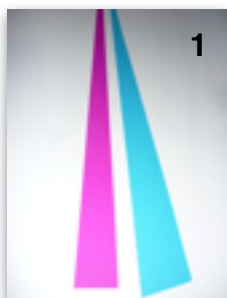

## Rolled Paper Beads



### Materials Needed

- light weight card in different colours
- firm quality magazine paper
- roll on glue Marbig Glue tape
- knitting needle
- paper cutter
- decorative metallic pens
- ribbon/cord
- large hole beads

## Rolled Paper Beads by Samantha Pope 2012

1. Cut long triangles from assorted coloured card and papers. Select a knitting needle or round shaft pen in a thickness that will accommodate the hole size required for threading.

2. Start at the wide end of the triangle and wrap the base around the knitting needle tightly. Apply some glue to the inside of the card and continue rolling the triangle around the needle tightly.

3. Keep the tapering triangle positioned in the centre of the wrap so the bead has an oval shape.

Continue applying glue now and then to secure the bead shape as you go.

4. Apply more glue to the inside edge of the pointy end of the bead and roll closed.

5. Decorate the bead with the metallic pen. Slide the bead off the needle.

6. Thread the beads onto some ribbon or cord. At each end thread a large holed bead and tie it off to secure the ends so the rolled beads don't move. Cut the ribbon long enough so you can slid it over your head or so there is enough to tie

a bow at the back of your neck.

7. For long triangle beads cut the card into a triangle with one straight edge and one angled edge. Roll the bead so that the straight edge makes a flat base at the bottom of the bead.
