What do Guides need?

Your daughter won't need anything for her first few meetings to experience the fun and adventure of Guides, though you should ensure that she wears suitable clothing for each meeting/event/activity. Girlguiding produces a range of Guide items: after a few weeks your daughter will need a handbook called a *G file*, and she can choose from a selection of Guide uniform. It is up to you, your daughter and her Leader to agree when it would be best for your daughter to start wearing her Guide uniform and using her *G file*.

Welcome to Guides

Guides get involved in everything - from adventure sports and performing arts to travelling and taking part in community action projects. Guides have the chance to get out there and do something really different. They are girls aged 10 to 14 who explore new places, go on camps, holidays and trips (sometimes abroad!), meet new friends at events like the BIG GIG, and try exciting activities. By joining, your daughter can become part of a worldwide community of girls who come together to have fun, learn and make things happen.

Guides make, or work towards making, this simple Promise, which they share with members around the world:

I promise that I will do my best:
To be true to myself and develop my beliefs,
To serve the Queen and my community,
To help other people
and
To keep the Guide Law.

Buying directly from Girlguiding means that all the profits go back into supporting guiding in the UK.

What will Guides cost?

Guide units charge subscriptions (called 'subs') weekly, monthly or termly to cover costs like equipment and the hire of the meeting place. There is also an annual subscription (which may be included in the subs), which is paid to cover the day-to-day running of the charity. Your daughter's Leader will let you know the amount as well as how and when to pay. For events like camps, holidays or Adventure days, an extra charge is usually made.

If you pay income tax, your daughter's Leader can use Gift Aid to claim 25p for every £1 you give in subs or donations. All you need to do is sign the Gift Aid Declaration form included here (page 5). The money will be used for the benefit of your daughter's Guide unit.

Support your daughter

Girlguiding encourages you to support your daughter's involvement in Guides.

- Drop off and collect her at the appropriate times. Always ensure that an adult Leader is present before you leave your daughter, and inform a Leader if someone different will be collecting your daughter.
- Return forms and payments on time. It is understood that you give your permission for your daughter to take part in
 guiding activities during the normal meeting time, but your written permission is sometimes needed for her to take part
 in events, outings or more adventurous activities at a different time or place.
- Discuss with your daughter's Leader any matters that may affect your daughter's participation, such as changes in family circumstance or any additional needs/medical conditions, and inform her promptly of any changes to your contact details.
- Encourage your daughter to attend meetings regularly and take part in special activities. Occasionally she may also want to do things at home, so be ready to help out with these too.

If you have any difficulties please talk to your daughter's Leader, who will treat what you say in confidence.
