



Lochboisdale Gateway Garden - Case Study

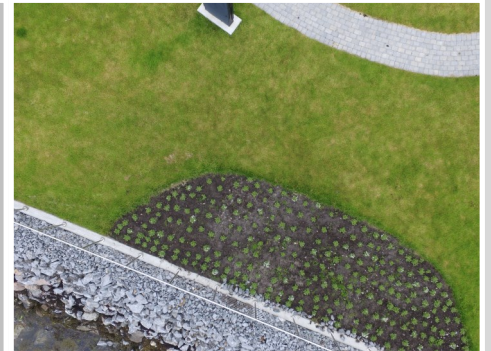

These works were designed to regenerate the derelict fishing pier at Lochboisdale, Isle of South Uist. The regeneration would provide a garden area for locals and tourists to relax and take in the views by the seaside, while also giving an area to hold pop-up events such as markets.

MacAulay Askernish Ltd was the main contractor for this project, excavating the site and replacing with rock infill and capped with recycled and treated topsoil. The works involved hard landscaping and soft landscaping throughout. With various different surfaces used, including Monobloc and bitumen surfacing. We constructed dry stone walls around the perimeter, keeping the natural but elegant style intact. All works were carried out in-house.
