



2020 FLEA BEETLE COLLECTION'S

Directions from Belfield: Take Highway 85 North out of Belfield for 8.5 miles. Turn West onto Franks Creek Road. Travel Franks Creek Road 15 miles, the sweeping location will be at an approach on your right hand side with a tan electrical box next to it and a power pole with yellow ground. Signs will be set up along Franks Creek Road where to turn off to get to the collection site.

Directions from Medora: Travel North through the Theodore Roosevelt National Park until you exit the park and enter onto East River Road. Travel East River Road for 5.7 miles then take a left onto Franks Creek Road and travel 2 miles. Look for tan electrical box on your left hand side and a power pole with yellow ground on your right hand side. Signs will be set alongside Franks Creek Road where to turn off to get to the collection site.

(The two-track trail into location is rough and is best accessed with a pickup or four wheel drive vehicle.)
