Mountain Pleasure Horse Association Guidelines for Appendix Registration Effective January 18, 2017

Criteria for Appendix Registry

- 1. Must be registered with one of the other Mountain Horse registries (RMHA or KMSHA)
- 2. Their genealogy must show at least 50% Mountain Bloodlines for 2 generations.
- 3. Must be a mare or a gelding
- 4. Must have DNA or Blood Typing to prove parentage

Registration of Appendix Horses

Submit to the MPHA Registrar;

- 1. A copy of horse's registration papers
- 2. A copy of horse's DNA or Blood typing report to prove parentage
- 3. 4 pictures of horse (front, rear, left and right sides) for identification
- 4. A completed Registration form
- 5. Payment of \$25 for registration. (\$45 for a DNA kit if no DNA report is presented). The registration fee of \$25 will be refunded if the horse does not meet the above criteria and can not be registered.

If criteria are met, the appendix horse will be issued registration papers light blue in color that identified said horse as Appendix MPHA. Appendix horses will have the same privileges as full Mountain Pleasure Horses in the show ring or on the trail. The only exception would be in the case of receiving KHBIF money if the situation should arise.

Progeny of appendix horses cannot be upgraded to purebred status, but will be maintained in the appendix registry.
