HEALTH WATCH

Local pediatricians are concerned about increased bacterial pneumonia cases in Fairbanks. Symptoms come on quickly and may include:

Cough (usually mucus), fever, fast or short of breath, shaking from chills, chest pain, increased heartbeat, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea. Mild symptoms are called "walking pneumonia". A visit to the doctor for prescribed antibiotics is the usual treatment (viral pneumonia is usually not treated with antibiotics). Please help us keep our school friends healthy by keeping children home if they are exhibiting these signs until they can be seen by their doctor.
